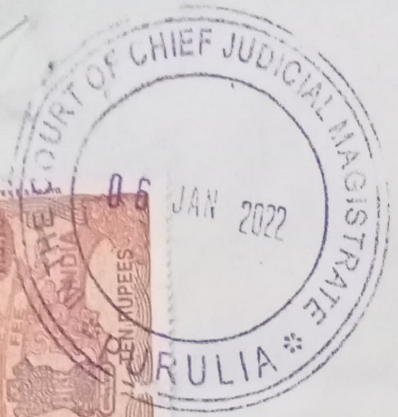

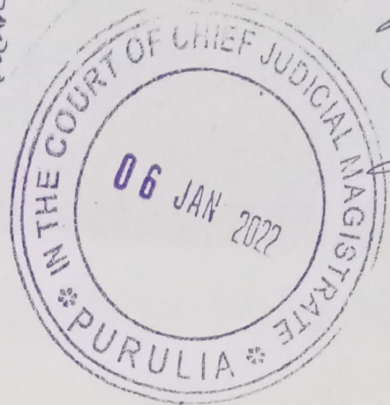

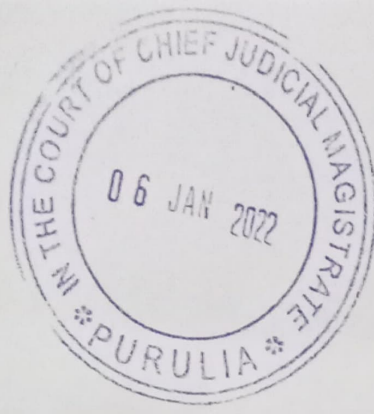

The above name complainant begs to state as follows:

- 1) That the complainant and the accused persons are the permanent resident of resident of village & P.O. Lalpur, P.S. Hura, Dist- Purulia
- 2) That the property belonged to the complainant is situated at mouza Lalpur under P.S. Hura recorded as J.L. No. 40, L.R. Khatian no. 1282 corresponding to L.R. Plot no. 1573, having an total area 41 decimals out of it 14 decimal is his ancestral property and the complainant have got 1/3rd share i.e. measuring 14 decimals and the rest portion has been allotted in favour of the complainant, two other brothers and they separated the land and demarcated the same and accordingly they are possessing their demarcated portion unconcerned with other having my valid right and possession over the same.
- 3) That the complainant have constructed one house and used the same in various purposes and the rest portion has been used for cultivation. But the accused person mentioned in the above are very dangerous and desperate in nature in the locality, they for some time back is trying to grab the property as it is situated by the side of the road and is a very valuable property and it is as good as bastu.

- 4) That in such circumstances the above noted accused persons on 12/12/2021 at about 11:00 am armed with lathi, iron rod etc criminally trespassed in to the land of the complainant and forcibly and illegally cut tranches with a view to make construction. Seeing such illegal activities the complainant protested, then the above noted accused persons assaulted the complainant with the help of lathi for that the complainant sustained injury on his person for which the complainant fell down on the ground, thereafter the accused persons damaged and bread a portion of his house for which he sustained los of Rs. 20,000/-
- 5) That apart they have taken away some equipment of construction work which the complainant have kept in his house for which causing loss of Rs. 15,000/- approximately.
- 6) That it is very pertinent to point out that the complainant is a chronic patient of heart and is a very law abiding citizen in the locality having every regard to law and its order, and is a very week person on the other hand the above named accused persons are very healthy and physically fit and they have no regard to law and its order, they also threatened the complainant with dare consequences and also gave out that they will murder

the complainant when they got opportunity and for that the complainant is passing his days in a panic stricken condition and not in a position to move freely.

- 7) That the accused person committed various offences punishable under the Indian penal code for which he is deserved to be punished under the law.
- 8) That the matter was reported to the Officer-in-charge Hura P.S. against the accused persons but the said Officer-in-charge did not taken any legal action after passage of considerable time, then the complainant lodged another complaint to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia but with same fate, then the complainant is under compelling circumstances is filing this complaint before the Ld. Court for appropriate reliefs under the law.
