In producing herewith, the 08 (Eight) persons namely 1. Bagan Kumar (50) S/o Sonu Kumar of village Masina, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 2. Ramkrishna Mahato (43) S/o Late Ananda Mahato of village Ankura, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 3. Paran Mahato (36) S/o Late Nunuram Mahato of village Metalya, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 4. Kartik Chandra Nayak (35) S/o Late Sristidhar Nayak of village Masina, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 5. Aghnu Kumar (36) S/o Gobardhan Kumar of Do, 6. Bhairab Kumar (48) S/o Late Sambhu Kumar of Do, 7. Kritibas Mahato (37) S/o Late Sahadar Mahato of village Pere-Torang, PS-Baghmundi, Dist-Purulia and 8. Gunadhar Mahato (23) S/o Late Lachu Mahato of Do.

The fact of the case in a nut shell is that today i.e. on 17/01/2022, I SI Jayanta Kr. Chakraborty along with force namely (i) C/730 Somnath Biswas, (ii) JC/1351 Saddam Ansary & HG/1722 Sripati Mandal all of Tulin OP were performing mobile duty as well as Naka duty at Masina more on Jhalda-Ranchi road from 16:25hrs for the implementation of the Govt. Order regarding all to wear Mask. This refers to Tulin OP under Jhalda PS GDE No 480 dated 17/01/2022 and C.C No 98/22 dated 17/01/22. During the Naka duty at Maru more, I intercepted the following above noted 08 (Eight) persons noted in the supra (SI no 1-8), who were loitering aimlessly without wearing the mask and not maintaining the social distance. On being asked they could not give sufficient reason or satisfactory answer for not wearing the mask after violating the Government Order in this pandemic situation. Consequently, it reasoned to believe that they violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dtd 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 15/05/2021, Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dtd. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd. 14.07.21 and Memo No-753/IV-ISS/2M-22/2021 dtd-29/07/2021 & Memo No- -753/V-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated-13/08/2021 & Memo No- 753/XVI-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd-02/01/2022 & Memo No- 753/XX-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd-15/01/2022. Consequently, the supra noted persons were arrested on the spot from 16:35 hrs to 17:10 hrs and informed them about the ground of their arrest and issued memo of arrest in respect of them.

As the supra noted persons violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dtd 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 15/05/2021, Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dtd. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd. 14.07.21 and Memo No-753/IV-ISS/2M-22/2021 dtd-29/07/2021 & Memo No- -753/V-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated-13/08/2021 & Memo No- 753/XVI-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd-02/01/2022 & Memo No- 753/XX-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd-15/01/2022. Ergo, they can be booked U/S 188 of the IPC and 51 (b) of the Disaster Management Act 2005 and read with section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act. 1897. Ergo a specific case may kindly be initiated against them and arranged for its investigation.
