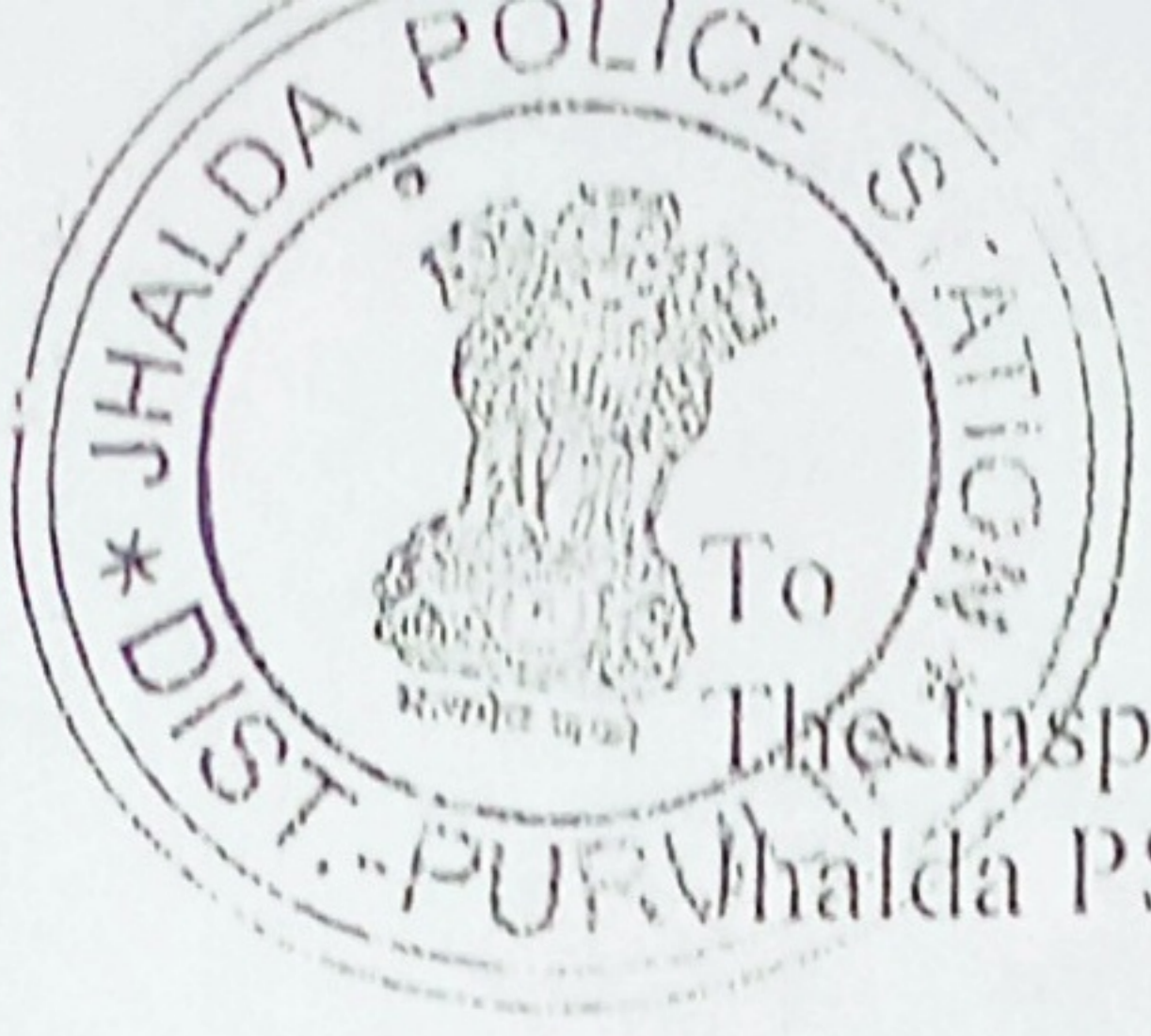

In producing herewith, the 10 (Ten) persons namely 1. Hari Pada Mahato (62) S/O Lt. Gupi Nath Mahato of village Kashidih, PS-Kotshila, Dist-Purulia, 2. Debojoti Roy (20) S/O Lt. Dhananjoy Roy of village Pat Jhalda, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 3. Gaure Chand Mahato (40) S/O Lt. Nandalal Mahato of village Madhupur, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 4. Joyanta Mahato (30) S/O Subal Mahato of village Mohada, PS-Kotshila, Dist-Purulia, 5. Samir Kumar (32) S/O Kuilu Kumar of village Durgu, PS-Kotshila, Dist-Purulia, 6. Nagendranath Mahato (46) S/O Kamal Mahato of village Kudagara, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 7. Damodar Kumar (24) S/O Manu Kumar of village Patrahatu, PS-Kotshila, Dist-Purulia 8. The fact of the case in a nut shell is that today i.e. on 19/01/2022, I LSI Anima Adhikary along with force namely (i) C/1207-Tarit Kr. Majhi, (ii) C/1496-Subal Ch. Mahato (iii) HG/1681-Manmotha Kumar (iv) NVF/778-Samir Ch. Mahato all of Jhalda PS were performing evening mobile duty as well as Naka duty at Birsha more on Jhalda-Ranchi road from 17:15 hrs for the implementation of the Govt. Order regarding all to wear Mask. This refers to Jhalda PS under Jhalda PS GDE No 749 dated 19/01/2022 and C.C No 189/22 dated 19/01/22. During the Naka duty at Birsha more, I intercepted the following above noted 10 (Ten) persons noted in the supra (Sl no 1-10), who were loitering aimlessly without wearing the mask and not maintaining the social distance. On being asked they could not give sufficient reason or satisfactory answer for not wearing the mask after violating the Government Order in this pandemic situation. Consequently, it reasoned to believe that they violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dtd 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 15/05/2021, Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dtd. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd. 14.07.21 and Memo No-753/IV-ISS/2M-22/2021 dtd-29/07/2021 & Memo No- 753/V-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated-13/08/2021 & Memo No- 753/XVI-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd-02/01/2022 & Memo No- 753/XX-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd-15/01/2022. Consequently, the supra noted persons were arrested on the spot from 17:35 hrs to 18:20 hrs and informed them about the ground of their arrest and issued memo of arrest in respect of them.

As the supra noted persons violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dtd 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 15/05/2021, Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dtd. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd. 14.07.21 and Memo No-753/IV-ISS/2M-22/2021 dtd-29/07/2021 & Memo No- 753/V-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated-13/08/2021 & Memo No- 753/XVI-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd-02/01/2022 & Memo No- 753/XX-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd-15/01/2022. Ergo, they can be booked U/S 188 of the IPC and 51 (b) of the Disaster Management Act 2005 and read with section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act. 1897. Ergo a specific case may kindly be initiated against them and arranged for its investigation.

Received on 19.1.22 at 18.45 hrs and started Jhalda PS case no 12/22 dtd 19.1.22 U/S 188 of the IPC and 51(b) of the Disaster Management Act-2005 and read with section 3 of Epidemic Diseases Act 1897 and endorsed to Asst Sisir Kr. Gope for its investigation.
