The fact of the case in a nut shell is that I SI Sujit Das along with force namely (i) C/696-Gorapad Pal (ii) 12077-Tarit Kr. Majhi (iii) HG/1829 Subodh Ch Mahato (iv) HG/1681 Monmotha Kumar were performing the evening mobile duty at Jhalda Bus stand under Jhalda PS. Subsequently I along with force arrived at spot on 12.01.2022 at 22:05 hrs. for the implementation of the Govt Order regarding the night restriction. This refers to Jhalda PS GDE No 489 dtd. 12.01.2022 in consonance with C.C No 123/22 Dtd. 12.01.2022. During the naka duty at Jhalda Bus stand, I intercepted the above noted 14 (Fourteen) persons noted in the supra (SI no 01-14), who were loitering aimlessly without wearing the mask and not maintaining the social distance. On being asked they could not give sufficient reason or satisfactory answer of their unwarranted loitering after violating the Government order in this pandemic situation. Consequently, it reasoned to believe that they violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dtd 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 15/05/2021 and Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dtd. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd. 14.07.21 and Memo No-753/IV-ISS/2M-22/2021 dtd-29/07/2021 & Memo No-753/V-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated-13/08/2021. Thereafter in addition to the order of Govt. Of West Bengal for all outdoor activities from 22:00 hrs to 05:00 hrs vide Memo No- 753/XVI-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd-02/01/2022. Consequently, the supra noted persons were arrested on the spot and informed them the ground of their arrest and issued memo of arrest in respect of them.

As the supra noted persons violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dtd 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 15/05/2021 and Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dtd. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd. 14.07.21 and Memo No-753/IV-ISS/2M-22/2021 dtd-29/07/2021 & Memo No-753/V-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated-13/08/2021. Thereafter in addition to the order of Govt. Of West Bengal for all outdoor activities from 22:00 hrs to 05:00 hrs vide Memo No- 753/XVI-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd-02/01/2022. Ergo, they can be booked U/S 188 of the IPC and 51 (b) of the Disaster Management Act 2005 and read with section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897. Ergo a specific case may kindly be initiated against them and arranged for its investigation.
