With due respect I SI Dibakar Kuiri of Joypur PS, beg to submit before you that on 15/01/2022 at about Sir. 21:35 hrs while myself along with force were performing Night Mobile duty at PS area and conducting raid against non-vearing of mask physical distancing maintaining Joypur Bazar near Arsha More as per order of my superior vide Govt. Memo No. 715-Home (Com)/RIM/ (Com)-92/21 dated. 17.34.2021 of Govt. of West Bengal regarding any violation of masks and social distance norms should be strictly dealt with and Order No-753/XVII-ISS/2M-22/2020 Date-02/01/2022, Joypur PS GDE No-686 Date-15/01/2022 & CC No-173/22 Date-15/01/2022 and found the following persons were roaming near Joypur Bazar near Arsha More without any face cover / mask & were gather near Joypur Bazar near Arsha More without maintaining physical distancing. Inspite of several request & reminder they refused to wear mask and roaming at public place. To prevent the spread of Covid-19 pandemic situation. I asked them to wear mask but they did not comply my request. Myself along with accompanied force detained them at Joypur Bazar near Arsha More they were coming from others villages. On being asked the following persons could not able to give any satisfactory answer for their presence at public place without face cover / mask and roaming aimlessly, violating the night lockdown order. In this pandemic situation of CORONA Virus/COVID-19 the above noted persons violated the order duly promulgated by Government order vide Memo No. 715-Home (Com)/RIM/ (Com)-92/21 dated. 17.04.2021 of Govt. of West Bengal regarding any violation of masks and social distancing norms should be strictly dealt with and Order No-753/XVII-ISS/2M-22/2020 Date-02/01/2022.
