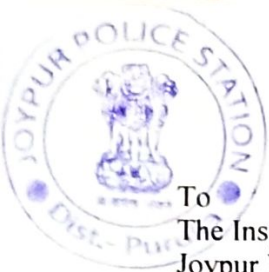

Sub: Prayer for lodging F.I.R. against arrested accused persons namely **Prasenjit Mahato (20 yrs) S/o-Sudarshan Mahato of Vill-Srirampur PS-Joypur Dist-Purulia & 06 others.**

Sir,

With due respect I SI Manas Kr Panda of Joypur PS, beg to submit before you that on 20/01/2022 at about 21:35 hrs while myself along with force were performing Night Mobile duty at PS area and conducting raid against non-wearing of mask physical distancing maintaining Joypur Bazar near Arsha More as per order of my superior vide Govt. Memo No. 715-Home (Com)/RIM/ (Com)-92/21 dated. 17.04.2021 of Govt. of West Bengal regarding any violation of masks and social distance norms should be strictly dealt with and Order No-753/XX-ISS/2M-22/2020 Date-15/01/2022, Joypur PS GDE No-915 Date-20/01/2022 & CC No-232/22 Date-20/01/2022 and found the following persons were roaming near Joypur Bazar near Arsha More without any face cover / mask & were gather near Joypur Bazar near Arsha More without maintaining physical distancing. In spite of several request & reminder they refused to wear mask and roaming at public place. To prevent the spread of Covid-19 pandemic situation. I asked them to wear mask but they did not comply my request. Myself along with accompanied force detained them at Joypur Bazar near Arsha More they were coming from others villages. On being asked the following persons could not able to give any satisfactory answer for their presence at public place without face cover / mask and roaming aimlessly, violating the night lockdown order. In this pandemic situation of CORONA Virus/COVID-19 the above noted persons violated the order duly promulgated by Government order vide Memo No. 715-Home (Com)/RIM/ (Com)-92/21 dated. 17.04.2021 of Govt. of West Bengal regarding any violation of masks and social distancing norms should be strictly dealt with and Order No-753/XX-ISS/2M-22/2020 Date-15/01/2022. As such the following persons violated the order during this pandemic situation. Moreover the detained persons refused to comply the direction given by the Central Govt. & the State Govt. to combat the severity of COVID-19 pandemic. The accused persons also tried negligently to spread infection of disease dangerous to life. Accordingly the following persons were arrested on 20/01/2022 from 22:10 hrs to 22:40 hrs, after maintaining all formalities regarding arrest prepared arrest memos and brought them to P.S.

- (1) Prasenjit Mahato (20 yrs) S/o-Sudarshan Mahato of Vill-Srirampur PS-Joypur Dist-Purulia.
- (2) SK Javed (51 yrs) S/o-SK Sahabad of Vill-Garhjoypur (Namopara) PS-Joypur Dist-Purulia.
- (3) Bibek Ch Mahato (23 yrs) S/o-Nitai Ch Mahato of Vill-Jorrow PS-Joypur Dist-Purulia
- (4) Brihaspati Mahato (29 yrs) S/o-Mankar Mahato of Vill-Jaratard PS-Arsha Dist-Purulia
- (5) Sunil Mahato (23 yrs) S/o-Parikhit Mahato of Vill-Shyampur PS-Joypur Dist-Purulia
- (6) Gurupada Kumar (47 yrs) S/o-Shashi Kumar of Vill-Rahardaga PS-Joypur Dist-Purulia
- (7) Santosh Majhi (40 yrs) S/o-Paltu Majhi of Vill-Alkusha PS-Joypur Dist-Purulia

All the arrested accused persons are liable for prosecution U/S-269/188/34 IPC & 51 (1) (b) of Disaster Management Act, 2005.

As the offence is bailable, So all the arrested accused persons were released on bail after furnishing bail bond vide Joypur PS GDE No- Date-20/01/2022.

Hence it is prayed before you that above mentioned persons may kindly be prosecuted U/S - 269/188/34 IPC & 51 (1) (b) of Disaster Management Act, 2005. Copy of order attached herewith.
