Sir,

In producing herewith 07 (Seven) arrested accused persons 1) Joydeb Mahali (29 yrs) S/o Lt. Binay Mahali 2) Dilip Mahato (35 yrs) S/o Lt. Nanu Mahato 3) Pradip Tantubai (41 yrs) S/o Bharat Tantubai 4) Ramu Murmu (55) S/o Lt. Rameswar Murmu 5) Baghambar Mahali (24 yrs) S/o Lt. Jaladhar Mahali 6) Santosh Mahali (25 yrs) S/o Biru Mahali all of vill.- Henselbera, PS- Kotshila, Dist- Purulia 7) Nibaran Murmu (30 yrs) S/o Kartick Ch. Murmu of vill. Bartar- Rigid PS- Kotshila, Dist- Purulia.

I beg to state that today (10.01.2022) night at about 03.25 hrs I SI Debabrata Chakraborty with C/633 Dasarath Singh Mura, C/ 970 Dolan Biswas and NVF- 940 Bhairab Mahato were performing night patrolling duty at Henselbera village side and found the above noted persons were coming from village side and moving aimlessly without wearing mask at the moment of night lockdown period. On seeing Police they tried to escape from the grip of police party but some of them failed to escape due to efficient effort of Police. On being asked, they disclosed their identity as noted above & they were loitering there without any purpose.

In this pandemic situation of CORONA Virus/COVID-19 the above noted persons violated the order duly promulgated by government and order vide memo no. 715-Home(Com)/RIM/(Com)-92/21 dated. 17.04.2021 of Govt. of West Bengal regarding any violation of masks and social distance norms should be strictly dealt with and memo no. 486-CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021 of Govt. of West Bengal & Order no- 753-ISS/2M-22/2020, Dt- 14/06/2021 & Order no- 753/II-ISS/2M-22/2020, Dt- 28/06/2021 & Order no- 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020, Dt- 14/07/2021 & Order no-753/IV-ISS/2M-22/2020, Dt- 29/07/2021 & 753/XVII-ISS/2M-22/2020, Dt- 02.01.2022 So, I arrested them for disobedience of order duly promulgated by public servant. After maintaining all rules of arrest, issued memo of arrest. I informed them & their relatives regarding the ground of arrest i.e. as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). At prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. All the process was done in between 03.45 hrs to 04.35 hrs. There was every chance of breach of peace and requiring of offence if not arrested.

Therefore, I pray to you that a specific case may kindly be lodged against the above noted accused persons as they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to lie and violated the rule U/S 188/34 IPC and Section 51(1) (b) National Disaster Management Act- 2005 and arrange for investigation.
