Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Subal Mondal S/o Sridhar Mondal of Vill.- Boragoria, PS – Raghunathpur, Dist.- Purulia under arrest along with seized articles as per seizer list i.e. 03 (Three) Plastic container loaded with Cholai Approx – 25 Ltrs. And one plastic container empty and one 600 ml bottle (Dilse) with loaded Cholai as sample under proper seizure with label.

I SI Indrajit Sarkar of Raghunathpur PS hereby lodged a written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that on 14.01.2022 at about 10:15 hrs during my day mobile duty I received a credible source information that the above noted accused person was selling Cholai liquor illegally at Boragoria village road under this PS. On receipt such information I immediately informed the matter to IC of the PS and as per his direction I along with force left to work out the information (This refers to Raghunathpur PS CC No. 124/22 dated 14/01/2022). At 11:05 hrs we reached at Boragoria village road and my source shown the person from a distance who was selling the Cholai liquors at that place. We immediately reached there and surrounded him, but other people who were assembled there to purchase Cholai liquor, on seeing Police Party managed to flee away from the spot and found the huge quantity of Cholai liquor were kept there in concealing condition. On searched 3 (Three) Plastic container loaded with Cholai Approx – 25 Ltrs. And one plastic container empty was found there. On demand he failed to produce any license / authority of the said Cholai liquor. On interrogation he also made incoherent statement regarding possession of said Cholai liquor and told that he is usually selling the same to the villagers/pedestrian illegally. So, finding no any other alternative way I seized the above noted articles from the possession of the accused person and labeled, duly signed by the accused person & witnesses in between 11:15 hrs to 11:35 hrs in which one 600 ml bottle (Dilse) with loaded Cholai was kept as sample file with label. During interrogation he confessed his guilt as such I arrested him at 11:45 hrs after observing all the formalities as per law issuing memo of arrest as the accused person is liable for prosecution u/s-46A (c) of the Bengal Excise Act 1909.

I therefore pray that a specific Case may kindly be started against the accused person namely Subal Mondal S/o Sridhar Mondal of Vill.- Boragoria, PS – Raghunathpur, Dist.- Purulia u/s-46A (c) of the Bengal Excise Act 1909.
