Respected Sir,

I, Mrinmay Bhakta, PSI of Police, Santuri PS, Dist. - Purulia do hereby produce (1) Khokan Pramanik (55 yrs), S/O - Lt. Ratan Pramanik (2) Asit Pramanik (48 yrs), S/O - Lt. Ratan Pramanik both are Vill.- Rangadanga, (3) Rajesh Mandal (46 yrs), S/O - Naran Mandal, Vill.- Dhekshila, (4) Badal Kalindi (45 Yrs), S/O- Lt. Binod Kalindi, Vill- Sadhusaltora all are PS-Santuri, Dist- Purulia & do hereby lodge a written complaint against them, to the effect that today on 16.01.2022 while I along with force of Santuri PS as per direction engaged in Evening mobile duty within Santuri PS area, (Reference Santuri P.S. G.D.E No.554, Dt. 16.01.2022) for implementation of Government rules regarding Disaster Management Plan. On 16.01.2022 while we returning from Marbedia side under Santuri P.S jurisdiction and reached at Santuri Morh through Saltora- Raghunathpur Road at about 22:55 hrs. found that the above noted 04 (Four) persons were gossiping near Santuri Morh without wearing a mask and maintaining social distancing which violates the compliance of norms of wearing of mask and maintaining social distancing during this pandemic situation in c/w COVID-19. So, there is every reason to believe that the above noted persons were moving without wearing a mask and maintaining social distancing which violates the compliance of norms of wearing of mask during this pandemic situation and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Government rule (Memo No. 753/XX-ISS/2M-22/2020 Dated- 15<sup>th</sup> January 2022 Government of West Bengal 'Nabanna' 325, Sarat Chatterjee Road Howrah- 711102). So, I have arrested them maintaining all legal formalities as well as notifying the ground of arrest and informed their family members through local people.


