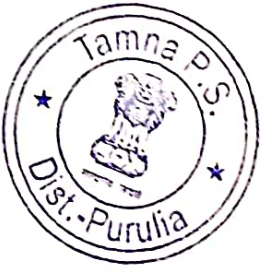

Sir,

I, SI Badal Paramanik S/O- Lt. Nirmal Ch. Harendranath Kaibarta of Vill- Chakaltore, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia, (4) Bimal Bhuiya (55 yrs) S/O- Lt. Shibaram Bhuiya of Vill- Tara, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia & (5) Buddheswar Sing Sardar (21 yrs) S/O- Samar Sig Sardar of Vill- Tamna, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia, and lodge a written complaint against them, to the effect that on 19.01.2022 while myself along with force of Tamna PS as per direction engaged in Special Night mobile duty within Tamna PS area, (Reference Tamna P.S G.D.E No. 806 dtd. 19.01.2022) for implementation of Government rules of Disaster Management Plan reached at Simulia more on 20.01.2022 at about 03:35 hrs and found that the above noted 05 (Five) persons were gossiping without wearing mask and not maintaining social distancing which violates the compliance of norms of wearing of mask and maintaining social distancing during this pandemic situation in c/w COVID-19. So, there is every reason to believe that the above noted persons were moving without wearing mask and not maintaining social distancing which violates the compliance of norms of Govt. of India as well as Govt. of West Bengal during this pandemic situation and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life. So, I have arrested them maintaining all legal formalities as well as notifying the ground of their arrest.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be started against accused (1) Ail Kuiry (39 yrs) S/O- Pagal Kuiry of Vill+ P.O- Chakaltore, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia, (2) Sanjay Rewani (26 yrs) S/O- Mathan Rewani of Vill+ P.O- Chakaltore, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia, (3) Manik Kaibarta (52 yrs) S/O- Lt. Harendranath Kaibarta of Vill- Chakaltore, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia, (4) Bimal Bhuiya (55 yrs) S/O- Lt. Shibaram Bhuiya of Vill- Tara, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia & (5) Buddheswar Sing Sardar (21 yrs) S/O- Samar Sig Sardar of Vill- Tamna, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia, under proper section of law as they ignored the norms of Govt. of India as well as Govt. of West Bengal and committed negligent Act. likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and arranged for its investigation.
