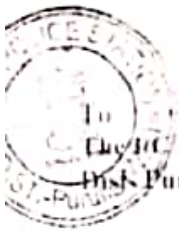

Sir,

In producing herewith 07 (Seven) arrested accused persons namely 1) Tarapada Mahato (55 Yrs) S/O Sanatan Mahato of Vill- Ranguni Adra (2) Ajay Malakar (19 Yrs) S/O Bardyanath Malakar of Panchodanga (3) Anant Misto (40 Yrs) S/O Gopal Misto of Upper Bemisol (4) Dayamoy Bauri (26 Yrs) S/O Durgadas Bauri of Vill-Jorisha (5) Abani Kanta Mahato (56 Yrs) S/O Lt. Sanatan Mahato of Rly. Qtr No-T-102 Unit-A (North Adra) (6) Sanu Bauri (30 Yrs) S/O Bansu Bauri of Ranguni Bauri Para all are PS-Adra, Dist- Purulia (7) Souren Mukharjee (40 Yrs) S/O Debabrata Mukharjee of Vill-Sanka, PS-Ragharanathpur Dist-Purulia with all connected papers

I beg to state that, today (18.02.2022), I was directed to find out whether the guidelines of Govt. regarding not wearing face mask in public in this pandemic situation has been implemented properly at Adra town area or not. Accordingly, I had been to Adra Bus Stand near Kashipur More along with force vide Adra PS CC No-677/22 dtd 18.02.2022 at about 21.05 hrs and found that none of them was wearing face mask. On seeing Police party they have tried to escape from the grip of police party but seven failed to escape due to efficiency effort of police party. On being asked they disclosed their identity as noted above.

They violated the order duly promulgated by government through public servants and through media etc. for prevention of attack from CORONA Virus/COVID-19. Though in view of Pandemic of COVID-19. They are creating annoyance to the society & violated this govt. order due to they not wear face mask/face covered.

I arrested them for disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest. Issued memo of arrest. I informed them & their relative regarding the ground of arrest provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). A prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. All the process was done at 21.05 hrs to 23.25 hrs. There was every chance of spread of infection of disease COVID-19 (CORONA VIRUS) which is endanger of human life.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be lodge under proper section of law against 07 accused persons as noted above. As they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases which is dangerous to life and arrange for investigation.
