Respected Sir,

In producing herewith 01 (one) seized vehicles (Tractors) having Reg. No **WB55E-2880, Eng. No D61251 & Chassis No. 4261264** attached with its loaded Sand Trolley and with proper Seizure list.

The nub of the fact in a nutshell is that on 18.02.2022 at 09:15 hrs while myself along with force 1) C/06 Debdas Mukherjee & 2) C/768 Ajit Murmu both of Purulia (M) PS left the PS for performing Spl. mobile duty vide Purulia (M) PS CC No 602/22 and GDE No 758 Dt. 18.02.2022 in PS area. During my Spl. mobile duty, I received a tip off at 14:25 hrs that 01 (one) tractor's driver & its owner were lifting sand illegally from Kansai river bed and said suspicious tractor loaded with sand at Patamputra Ghat. Subsequently, I along with force proceeded towards said Ghat to work out the tip off. While I along with force arrived at Patamputra Ghat and found that 01 (one) tractor loaded with sand ready to move. On being see the police party from far away, the driver of said vehicle (Tractor) fled away to avoid any touch of police. I along with force also chased the driver to detain but could not. Then I along with force intercepted the vehicle (Tractor) having Reg. No **WB55E-2880, Eng. No D61251 & Chassis No. 4261264** and I found the vehicle as well as goods as identical as I received prior information. I also informed the matter to you and as per your kind direction, I along with force were awaiting long time but none could turn up before me. It was ascertained that the driver of said tractor loaded the said sand in cahoots with the owner of the vehicle by illegal means for selling the same to make profit by dishonestly and they have been running a clandestine business. So it is reasoned to belief that driver of said vehicle in cahoots with the owner of the vehicle procured the said sand form Kansai River Bed at Patamputra Ghat by fraudulently means or theft by any means for transporting the same to run clandestine business. So I, seized the (Tractor) having Reg. No **WB55E-2880, Eng. No D61251 & Chassis No. 4261264** attached with Trolley loaded with Sand approx. 100 Cft. under proper seizure list. Thereafter, I brought the seized tractor with sand loaded trolley to Purulia (M) PS compound as per kind direction of you.

Under the above facts and circumstances kindly take lawful action against the driver as well as owner of the vehicle (Tractor) having **Reg. No WB55E-2880, Eng. No D61251 & Chassis No. 4261264**.
