Sir,

In producing here with the arrested accused persons namely **Shivshankar Kunwer** (age-26 yrs approx) S/O-Devnarayan Kunwer of Vill-Narsinghgarh, PS-Dhalbhumgarh & Janmenjoy Mahato (age-34 yrs approx) S/O-Lakhan Mahato of Vill-Pagda, PS-Boram both are of Dist-East Singbhum, Jharkhand along with seized Dumper Truck bearing Registration No- JH-05CZ/7013 loaded with stone chips approx 500 (five hundred) cft, I do hereby submitting written complain to the effect that today i.e. on 22.03.22 at about 10:15 hrs during my Day Patrolling duty, I received a source information that one stone chips loaded Dumper Truck bearing Registration No- JH-05CZ/7013 is standing since long by the side of Katin-Bandwan road near Liki petrol pump. He also informed me that stone chips which has been loaded in the Dumper Truck does not have proper challan. Accordingly, I had been to the spot being accompany with my force to verify the source information and found that stone chips loaded said Dumper Truck is remain stand.

Then, I asked the above noted persons to produce valid documents/ challan in respect of loaded stone chips as one of them namely Shivshankar Kunwer was addressing himself as the registered owner of said stone chips loaded Dumper Truck and other one namely Janmenjoy Mahato was addressing himself as driver. But, they failed to produce any valid documents/ challan in respect of loaded stone chips in the Dumper Truck as well as in respect of vehicle also though sufficient time was given. They were replying in incoherently manner and from their statements, there was sufficient reason to believe that they have procure stone chips by means of theft or fraudulently means and was trying to conceal those. Being asked, both the above noted accused persons disclosed their identity as noted above. Accordingly, I seized the Dumper Truck bearing Registration No- JH-05CZ/7013 loaded with approx 500 (five hundred) cft stone chips after preparing proper seizure list duly signed by the accused persons and witnesses.

After that, I arrested both the above noted accused persons after gathering sufficient evidence against them.

Hence, I pray before you that a cog case may kindly be started against the arrested accused persons namely (1) Shivshankar Kunwer (age-26 yrs approx) S/O-Devnarayan Kunwer of Vill-Narsinghgarh, PS-Dhalbhumgarh (2) Janmenjoy Mahato (age-34 yrs approx) S/O-Lakhan Mahato of Vill-Pagda, PS-Boram both are of Dist-East Singbhum, Jharkhand U/S-379/411/414 IPC and arrange its investigation.
