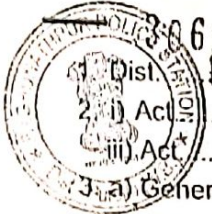

Sir,

In producing here with one vehicle (Truck) bearing registration No. WB 37D/8922 loaded with approx 18.5 MT steam coal under proper seizure, I beg to submit that on 14/03/2022 night myself SI Indrajit Sarkar along with force C/737 Haradhan Nayek , C/716 Achinta Majee , C/480 Uttam Bouri vide Raghunathpur PS CC No. 681/22 were engaged in night mobile duty at Raghunathpur PS area with Govt. Vehicle No. WB56C/6223. At about 00.35 hrs when we were at Biltora- Madhutati side received a tip off that some unknown miscreants stocked a large quantity of steam coal near Simulkundi village under Bero Mouza and preparing for loading the same in a Truck for transporting the same in a clandestine manner forming a racket. After getting information myself along with my accompanying forces rushed to the anticipated place with an intimation to my superior and as per direction we reached at near Simulkundi village at 01:45 hrs. and found a Truck parked there from a distance. I would like to note here that on way I have tried to collect local witnesses from the nearby villages. But due to dead hours of night all my efforts ended in vain. On seeing the Police Party from a distance the miscreants tried to flee away from the spot leaving behind the Truck bearing No WB 37D/8922 and could manage to escape despite our all efforts. On verification we found the said Truck is loaded with approx 18.5 MT steam coal.

On secret enquiry through my reliable source it came out that the owner of the truck with his full knowledge and consent sent this truck along with his driver for loading coal illegally for clandestine business after forming a racket with Mahesh Dubey @ Mahesh Thakur S/O Lt Rajen Dubey of Banshgarh PS Raghunathpur Dist Purulia the king pin of this racket procuring the steam Coal by theft or any dishonest means from illegal mines/ pits with a view to dispose off the same by transporting the Coal for their wrongful gain in a habitual manner and there by caused a loss of National property.

So, I seized the truck bearing Regd. No. WB 37D/8922 loaded with approx 18.5 MT steam coal after preparing a proper seizure list duly signed by my accompanying forces and brought to PS. I have also collected two sample 3 KG each from the stock of the said seized coal loaded in Truck No. WB 37D/8922.

Hence, on returned to PS with the above noted seized vehicle having Regd. No. WB 37D/8922 loaded with approx 18.5 MT steam coal and seized coal sample, I do here by lodge this complain with a prayer that a specific case may kindly be started against the owner, driver of the truck bearing Regd. No. WB 37D/8922 and Mahesh Dubey @ Mahesh Thakur S/O Lt Rajen Dubey of Banshgarh PS Raghunathpur Dist Purulia who is king pin of the racket under proper section of law and also arranging for its investigation.
