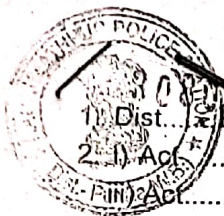

Sir,

In producing here with 18 Nos. vehicles (Truck) loaded with steam coal bearing registration No. WB 37C/6330 (approx 23 MT Coal), WB 81/0380 (approx 21 MT Coal), WB 81/2194 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 55/9794 (approx 18 MT Coal), WB 67A/1842 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 81/0771 (approx 23 MT Coal), WB 81/0542 (approx 23 MT Coal), WB 55/8369 (approx 19 MT Coal), WB 81/1436 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 81/1203 (approx 19 MT Coal), WB 81/1044 (approx 21 MT Coal), WB 67C/0290 (approx 19 MT Coal), WB 81/0424 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 55A/2131 (approx 23 MT Coal), WB 55A/3916 (approx 18 MT Coal), WB 55/9139 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 37C/9571 (approx 24 MT Coal) & WB 55/9798 (approx 20 MT Coal) under proper seizure, I beg to submit that on 19-20/04/2022 night on receiving source information about illegal coal transporting at Kargali area is being operated by someone in darkness, accordingly I SI Mukul Karmakar informed the matter to IC Raghunathpur PS and as per his direction I along with SI Tarapada Mandal and force vide Raghunathpur PS Spl. CC No. 152/22 dated- 19.04.2022 vide Raghunathpur PS GDE No 928 dated- 19.04.2022 and Officer & force of Chelliyama Night Mobile vide Raghunathpur PS CC No. 1057/22 dated- 19.04.2022 vide Raghunathpur PS GDE No 922 dated- 19.04.2022 station at Pakori More, Chelliyama went out for executing the credible source information about illegal transportation of coal by vehicle from Kargali area. At about 00:45 hrs when we reached at near Kargali Uparpara Durga Mandir and found that the above noted vehicles are standing in queue, on seeing the Police Party from a distance the drivers and khalasi fled away from the spot leaving behind those trucks. On verification we found the said Trucks are loaded with steam coal. Then we cordoned the area and informed the matter to IC Raghunathpur PS as well as started the search and seizure procedure. In the meantime IC Raghunathpur PS reached at the spot and then we seized those trucks bearing Regd. No. WB 37C/6330 (approx 23 MT Coal), WB 81/0380 (approx 21 MT Coal), WB 81/2194 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 55/9794 (approx 18 MT Coal), WB 67A/1842 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 81/0771 (approx 23 MT Coal), WB 81/0542 (approx 23 MT Coal), WB 55/8369 (approx 19 MT Coal), WB 81/1436 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 81/1203 (approx 19 MT Coal), WB 81/1044 (approx 21 MT Coal), WB 67C/0290 (approx 19 MT Coal), WB 81/0424 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 55A/2131 (approx 23 MT Coal), WB 55A/3916 (approx 18 MT Coal), WB 55/9139 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 37C/9571 (approx 24 MT Coal) & WB 55/9798 (approx 20 MT Coal) in between 01:45 hrs to 03:15 hrs. and arrange for transporting those trucks from the PO. After seizure of those coal loaded trucks we

brought those seized trucks and kept under guard at SDO office premises ground after preparing a proper seizure list duly signed by my accompanying forces. I have also seized sample 1 KG each from the each coal loaded seized vehicles. No public witnesses were available there due to odd hours of the night.

On secret enquiry through my reliable source it came out that the owner of those trucks with their full knowledge and consent sent those trucks along with their drivers for loading coal illegally for clandestine business after forming a racket with the owners, drivers and others king pin of this racket namely (1) Sadhan Das S/o Hari Das of Vill.- Kargali, PS – Raghunathpur, Dist.- Purulia, (2) Santosh Mondal S/o Sadhan Mondal of Do, (3) Fakir Mondal of Do, (4) Sricharan Gorai of Do, (5) Swapan Hazra of Do and (6) Ganesh Gorai of Do procuring the steam Coal by theft or any dishonest means from illegal mines/ pits with a view to dispose off the same by transporting the Coal for their wrongful gain in a habitual manner and there by caused a loss of National property.

Hence, on returned to PS with the above noted seized vehicles having WB 37C/6330 (approx 23 MT Coal), WB 81/0380 (approx 21 MT Coal), WB 81/2194 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 55/9794 (approx 18 MT Coal), WB 67A/1842 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 81/0771 (approx 23 MT Coal), WB 81/0542 (approx 23 MT Coal), WB 55/8369 (approx 19 MT Coal), WB 81/1436 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 81/1203 (approx 19 MT Coal), WB 81/1044 (approx 21 MT Coal), WB 67C/0290 (approx 19 MT Coal), WB 81/0424 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 55A/2131 (approx 23 MT Coal), WB 55A/3916 (approx 18 MT Coal), WB 55/9139 (approx 20 MT Coal), WB 37C/9571 (approx 24 MT Coal) & WB 55/9798 (approx 20 MT Coal) steam coal and seized coal sample, I do here by lodge this complain with a prayer that a specific case may kindly be started against the owner, drivers of those vehicles, king pin of this racket namely (1) Sadhan Das S/o Hari Das of Vill.- Kargali, PS – Raghunathpur, Dist.- Purulia, (2) Santosh Mondal S/o Sadhan Mondal of Do, (3) Fakir Mondal of Do, (4) Sricharan Gorai of Do, (5) Swapan Hazra of Do and (6) Ganesh Gorai of Do and unknown others, who were illegally stocked as such huge coal and king pin of the racket under proper section of law and also arranging for its investigation.
