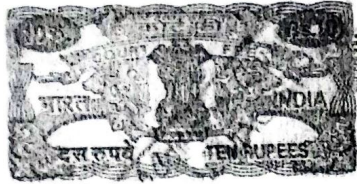

The complainant most respectfully sheweth:-

1. That the both complainant and the accused persons are the permanent resident of P.S.Para Dist.Purulia and within the jurisdiction of your Hon's court.
2. That the complainant is the only legally married wife of the accused no.01 and the marriage between the complainant and the accused no.01 was solemnized about 19 yrs. ago in the month of "BAISAKH" according to Hindu right, customs and usages prevailing in their community.
3. That during said marriage tie, both the parties blessed with two sons-1) Ajay Rajawar (now 18 yrs old) and 11) Suresh Rajawar (now 14 yrs. old) and one daughter 111) Anu Rajawar (now 06 yrs. old).
4. That during the said marriage the father of the complainant was compelled to pay a sum of RS.-50,000,- in cash, few golden & silver ornaments and some furniture to the accd. no:01 though the father of the complainant is a day labourer.
5. That after the 3 to 4 yrs. of marriage the complainant was subject to torture both mentally and physically by the hands of acced. persons, even the complainant was assaulted by her husband and brother-in-law's ~~and~~ at the night when they were condition in drunken, which the complainant informed to her parents time to time, but the parents always advice to the complainant to stay in her matrimonial house and one day the situation will be change.

6. That but in the year 2021 on the occasion at Kallipuja's night the accused persons without any reason assaulted the complainant with a intention to killed her, but the complainant anyhow manage to scape from the clutches of the acced. person and begain to shouting for help.

7. That ultimately the complainant alongwith her minor daughter and ^{one} son able to came out from her matrimonial house and reached her father house at midnight to vill. Nadina, P.S: Para, Dist. Purulia (W.B) and after reach there narrated the incident to her father, but due to her such mental condition she could not treated medically within time.

8. That thereafter father of the complainant tried to settled the dispute with the in-law's but no result and since then the complainant residing with her minor son and daughter in her father residence.

9. That on 06-03-22 (SUNDAY) the accd. no:01 came to the house of complainant's father home and tried to take back the complainant by force, but the complainant refuse to go back with him due to fear of such torture, as a result acced. no. 01 get furious and begain to assault the complainant by fist and blows in presence of member's of her paternal house, the persons present there raised objection of the high handed act of the acced. no.01, suddenly he left the place due to such incidence the complainant was not in a sound mental position why the complainant can't lodge complain within time.

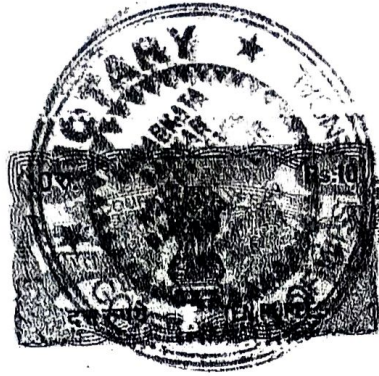

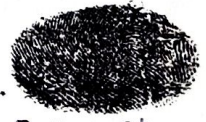
