Respected Sir,

In producing herewith (1) 03 (three) nos of Cycle, (2) 01(one) no of Water pump, (3) 02 (two) nos of rope, (4) 02 (two) nos of Belcha, (5) 04 (four) nos of Jhuri, (6) 02 (two) nos of Iron Dhama along with approx 42 (Forty two) tons coal out of this 01 (one) kg coal seized as Sample with proper seizure list. The fact of the case in brief is that on 24.05.22 at about 21:35 hrs myself along with force C/188 Debabrata Bauri and C/223 Tanas Singh were on night mobile duty on Sarbari – Saltora road and received a source information that some persons in the outskirts of Jadurdih village in open field engaged in extracting coal from different pits in illegal ways after forming a racket to deal in with such property for clandestine business with a view to wrongful gain.

Accordingly I informed the matter to O/C Santuri PS and as per his direction I along with force went there to work out the information.

Accordingly I along with accompanying force reached at that spot at about 22: 15 hrs. Seeing our police van from a distance some people who were engaged in extracting coal managed to escape before we could get at them. We could not identify the persons as there was lack of light. After that we searched the spot and found (1) 03 (three) nos of Cycle, (2) 01(one) no of Water pump, (3) 02 (two) nos of rope, (4) 02 (two) nos of Belcha, (5) 04 (four) nos of Jhuri, (6) 02 (two) nos of Iron Dhama along with approx 42 (Forty two) tons coal out of this 01 (one) kg coal seized as Sample beside the mouth of those illegal coal pits. Accordingly, I held local enquiry to know the involved persons to establish identity but failed. So, I seized the above noted articles with proper seizure list duly signed by the available witnesses on 24/05/2022 in between 23:15 hrs to 23:45 hrs. It is reasonable to believe that those unknown miscreants who managed to flee away from that spot were engaged for extracting, lifting and transporting of illegal coal for clandestine business hatching a criminal conspiracy with a view to wrongful gain after forming a racket. So the some unknown miscreants are liable for committed an offence punishable U/S 379/411/414/120B IPC & r/w Sec 30(2) CMN Act.

I therefore pray that kindly start a specific case against those unknown miscreants as per law and arrange its investigation.
