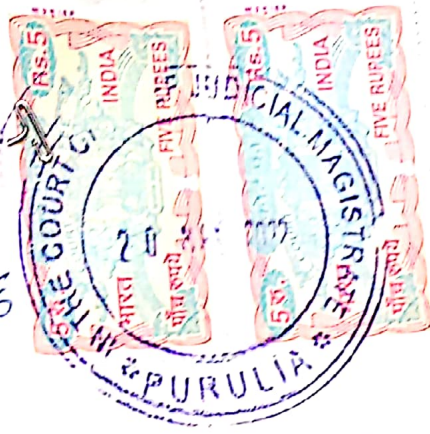

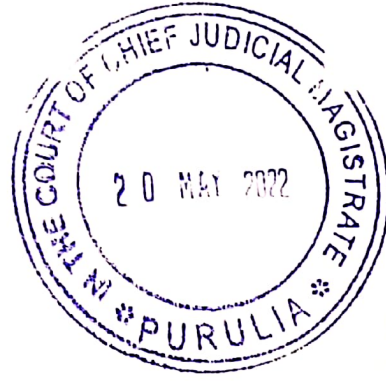

The above name complainant begs to state as follows:

- 1) That the complainant and the accused persons are the permanent resident of village- Madla, P.S. Baghmundi, Dist- Purulia.
- 2) That on the date of incident i.e. on 20/04/2022 corresponding to 6th Baisakh-1429 B.S. the said accused Tapan Kumar all on a sudden kidnapped the daughter of the complainant namely Kumari Pratima Mura without his permission and knowledge and abducted her daughter from his custody and kept her daughter in an unknown place. The other persons namely Tapan Kumar, Pasuram Kumar and wife of Tapan

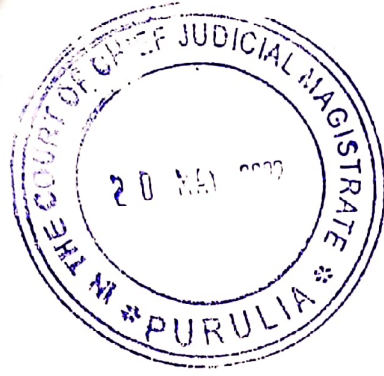

Kumar instigated and abated the said Umesh Kumar to commit such crime.

- 3) That when the complainant learnt about such incident he search for his daughter in all probable places, and as his daughter is unmarried, the complainant did not disclosed the same to anybody even the complainant did not lodged any complaint against the accused persons on the earlier occasion. But the complainant requested the said accused Tapan Kumar, Pasuram Kumar and wife of Tapan Kumar to bring back his daughter, but the accused persons without keeping request threatened the complainant with dare consequences. And ultimately the complainant is compelled to lodged this complainant.
- 4) That the complainant also know that the above mentioned accused persons under criminal conspiracy is trying to sell the said daughter of the complainant anywhere within the state of Uttar Pradesh in lieu of money.

- 5) That the accused persons committed various offences punishable under the Indian penal code for which he is deserved to be punished under the law.
- 6) That the matter was reported to the Officer-in-charge Baghmundi P.S. against the accused persons but the said Officer-in-charge did not taken any legal action then the complainant lodged another complaint to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia but with same fate, then the complainant is under compelling circumstances is filing this complaint before the Ld. Court for appropriate reliefs under the law.
