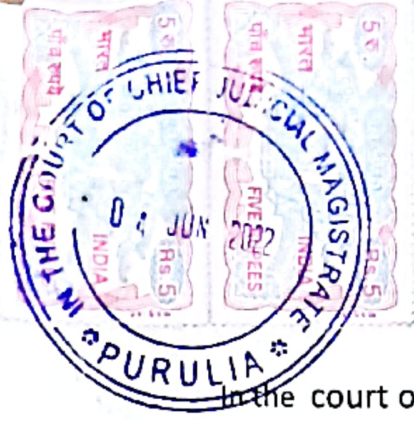

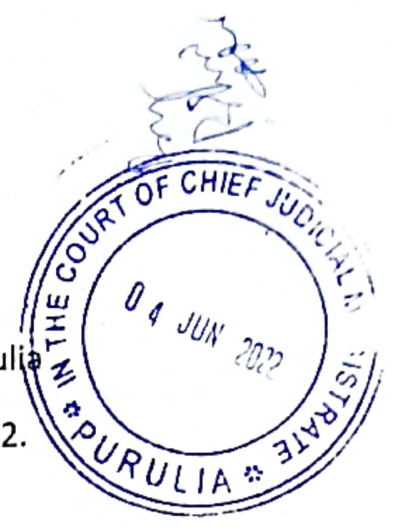

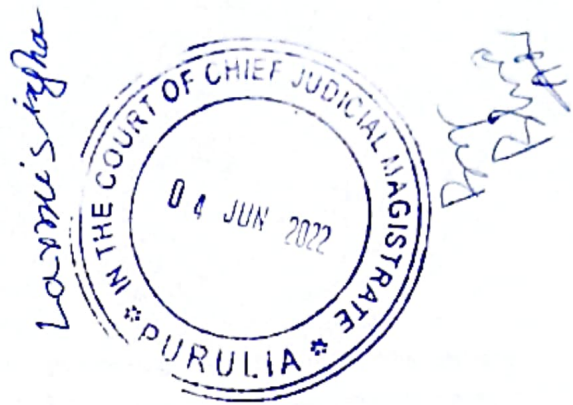

- **4. Occurrence :-** From the very inception of Marriage i.e. on 02-05-2018, corresponding to 18th. Baisakh 1425 B.S. and on wards particularly on 27th. Bhadra 1425 B.S. and 6th. Bhadra 1428 B.S. which is still continuing .

5. Offences :- U/S ~~498 A/323/34 I.P.C. & 3/4 Dowry Prohibition Act.~~

The above named complainant begs to state

as follows:-

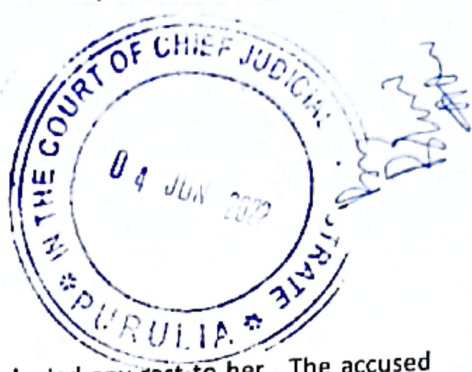
1---- That your petitioner is the legally married wife of accused Sunil Kumar Singha . The parties are Rajput by caste and Hindu by religion . Their marriage was solemnised on 02-05-2018 , according to their customary rites and formalities prevalent in their community. The Marriage is duly consummated and out of their wed loch a male child is born to them . The marriage tie between them still subsists . .

2----That at the time of marriage , as per demand of the accused persons , father of the petitioner had to give considerable dowry including a hard cash of Rs.4,30, 000/- , ornaments , utensils, Palanka , bedding etc. to the accused persons but the accused persons were not satisfied with the same .

3----That after marriage the petitioner had been to her matrimonial home with a lot of hope and started to live there as husband wife in a joint mess consisting of her parents in laws , Bhansur , Jhethani , Nanad, for 7/ 8 days or so thereafter her husband in collusion with his parents , sister , elder brother in law and Jethani started a fresh demand of Rs. 50,000/- form her father and asked to bring the same from her father . The accused persons also asked the petitioner to convey their demand to her father and she must bring the same otherwise she would have no place in their house they threatened . Accordingly your petitioner convey the fresh demand of the accused persons to her poor father who was very much surprised and shocked and expressed his inability to meet the fresh demand.

4----That when the money as demanded by the accused persons was not given by the poor father of the petitioner , all the accused persons became furious and vindictive towards the petitioner and started various mental and physical tortures upon the her without any fault .Off and on she was assaulted by her husband accused Sunil Kumar Singha , at the ill advise of the other accused persons . She was denied square meal by her mother in law, Nanad and Jethani . She was not allowed to enter the bed room of her husband and compelled her to do the entire work of the family from dawn to dusk .

She was treated as a unpaid maid servant and denied any rest to her . The accused Kunti Singha , Nanad Gita Singha and Jethani Nitu Singha used to poisoned the ear of her husband and insists him to beat the petitioner .The petitioner was help less at the hand of the accused persons .How ever she was conceived and hearing the pregnancy of the petitioner all the accused persons became furious and vindictive towards her , during her pregnancy she was driven out from her matrimonial home on 27th. Bhadra 1425 B.S. after severe assault . The petitioner gave birth to a male baby in the house of her father and hearing the news of her delivery all the accused persons came to the house of her father at village Basudih under P.S. Baghmundi and started to abused the petitioner in most possible filthy language . When the petitioner and her father protested , then the accused persons started to assault the petitioner and her father and fled away from the place hurriedly and surreptitiously with a threatening that they would not take the petitioner and her newly born baby to their house .

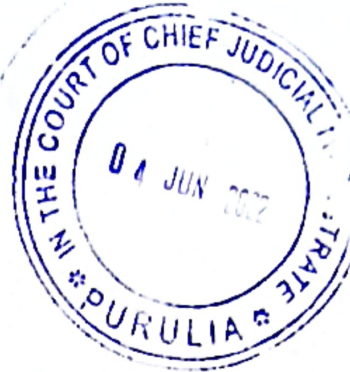
5----That after waiting for two years or so, on 6th . Bhadra 1428 B.S. again her father and one Ajit Singha reached the petitioner along with the baby to her matrimonial home but the accused persons did not allow her to enter the house and again drove her out holding the neck of the petitioner .The accused Sunil Kumar Singha negotiating for his second marriage with the sister of Nitu Singha and for that purpose he has bring her in his house and living as husband and wife with her .

6----That being a devoted Hindu wife , your petitioner had to bears those tortures, cruelties, assault patiently on the hope that her husband and other in laws would mend themselves and would be normal towards her but her hope was never materialised and became shattered . Day by day the volume of tortures, cruelties, and assault were gradually exercised upon the petitioner by all the accused persons which were unbearable and beyond description . Under compulsion the petitioner take shelter in the house of her father at village Basudih under P.S. Baghmundi .

8----That though the petitioner reported the matter to the local Police Station but the police was found evasive to take legal action against the accused persons best known to them . Thereafter , your petitioner knocked the door of the Superintendent of Police Purulia on 10-05-2022, but nothing has been done from his good office though the accused persons have committed the offences of causing persistent mental and physical and mental tortures, cruelty and assault to the complainant and the accused persons in furtherance of their common intentions have committed the offences of intentionally cause hurt to the complainant .
