Sir,

I do hereby submit complaint against (i) Mangal Hembram, S/o- Lt. Rahin Hembram (ii) Bhutnath Hembram, S/o- Lt. Kheku Hembram (iii) Thakurdas Murmu, S/o- Rathu Murmu (iv) Maheswar Bakey, S/o- Jugal Baskey (v) Bapi Hembram, S/o- Gopal Hembram (vi) Jiten Hembram, S/o- Puma Ch. Hembram (vii) Asari Sahis, S/o- Aghor Sahis all are of Vill- Karamara, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia (viii) Samir Mahata, S/o- Shaktipada Mahata of Vill- Barakdih, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia (ix) Raju Das, S/o- Lt. Mahadeb Das of Vill- Damda, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia and near about 30/40 other unknown local villagers of Karamara village, PS – Tamna to the effect that I was engaged on day Mobile duty vide C.C. No. 3458 dtd. 22.06.22. After received information from O/C Tamna PS that some villagers blockade the Purulia-Tata main road (NH-32) over the issue of RTA. To work out the information I along with force had been to Karamara village at about 09.15 hrs. and found that Purulia-Tata road (NH-32) had been blocked by above noted persons and near about 30/40 other unknown local villagers under the leadership of accused Mangal Hembram as noted above. They blocked the road on the issue of detained the unknown offending vehicle. I informed them that police give all efforts to detained the unknown offending vehicle. But the villagers demanded that road blockade will be continuing until detain of offending vehicle and started to raise agitation. I have tried to pursue the agitator to withdraw the blockade and help police to disperse the mob as well as discharge lawful duty. It was also found more than 50/60 vehicles loaded with goods and loaded with passengers and drivers including patients etc. in different areas were detained there and subjected to enormous suffering for a long time i.e. 09:05 hrs to 10:55 hrs. The above accused persons continued to be with the unlawful assembly, causing unlawful restraint to the vehicles & passer-by and thus generated danger & obstruction in public way and also caused obstruction to police in discharging Govt. duty. I had a few photographs of the incident through my mobile camera. After more or less 01 (one) and ½ (half) hour discussion, they withdrew the blockade at about 10:55 hrs. On returning to PS, I showed the photographs to my source, CVF & VP and could know the name of above accused only. So, I pray to start specific case against the above accused persons.
