Sir,

I, SI- Prasanta Sau along with force returned to PS and brought under seizure (i) one vehicle having Reg/. No- UP61T7251 loaded with approx 18 Ton steam coal (ii) One nylon green bag containing of Rs 5/- coin -1591X 5 in 16 packets=7955 and Rs 10 rupee coin 510x10 in 11 packets =5100 total 13055/- (iii) one white colour nylon bag containing with only notes of different denomination as Rs 500 rupee note 63 x500 =31500, 200 rupee note 50 x200 =10000, 100 rupee note 337 x100 =33700, 50 rupee note 113 x50 =5650, 20 rupee note 222 x20 =4440, 10 rupee note 1067 x10 =10670, 05 rupee note 10 x5 =50, total Rs 96010/- under proper seizure list and produced before your good self.

I beg to submit that today (25/07/2022) myself along with RM/1479 Rajib Biswakarma, RM/1498 Sachin Sewa were performing anticrime day mobile duty at Jhalda PS area. This refers to Jhalda PS GDE No. 1124 dt. 25/07/2022 and C.C. No- 1974/22 date- 25/07/2022. During day mobile duty at about 13:05 hrs I received a telephonic information from SDPO Jhalda that an unauthorized truck loaded with stolen steam coal was parked in a coal factory styled as R.D. Coke & Carbon situated at Brajapur under Jhalda PS. Subsequently I informed the matter to you and as per direction of SDPO Jhalda I along with SDPO Jhalda and force rushed to the spot. On reaching to the spot at 13:45hrs. I found that one truck parked at coal factory as identical as I received the information. But seeing the Police, driver of Truck fled away leaving the Truck on the spot. We tried to apprehend him but failed. We waited for reasonable time but none came to spot. So, it was ascertained that the driver of the truck having no UP61T7251 loaded the said steam coal in cahoots with the owner of the vehicle and others by illegal means for selling the same to make profit by dishonestly and they had been running a clandestine business. SDPO Jhalda Sir directed me to search the said truck. As such I immediately searched the said truck in presence of him and found it was loaded approx 18 Ton Steam Coal and also found One nylon green bag containing of Rs 5/- and Rs10/- coin in 27 packets total Rs13055/- and one white colour nylon bag containing with only notes of different denomination total Rs-96010/-. Subsequently, as per direct supervision of SDPO Jhalda Sir I seized (i) one vehicle having Reg/. No- UP61T7251 loaded with approx 18 Ton steam coal (ii) One nylon green bag containing of Rs 5/- coin - 1591X 5 in 16 packets=7955 and Rs 10 rupee coin 510x10 in 11 packets =5100 total 13055/- (iii) one white colour nylon bag containing with only notes of different denomination as Rs 500 rupee note 63 x500 =31500, 200 rupee note 50 x200 =10000, 100 rupee note 337 x100 =33700, 50 rupee note 113 x50 =5650, 20 rupee note 222 x20 =4440, 10 rupee note 1067 x10 =10670, 05 rupee note 10 x5 =50, total Rs 96010/- under proper seizure list duly signed by available witnesses. Though, I searched for the public witness but none was available there at that time. Thereafter, I arrived at PS with the seized articles.


