Most respectfully sheweth:-

- 1) That on 14.05.2022 (Saturday) at about 7.00 P.M. one Mulberry Tree and a Jackfruit Tree, so grown up quite over the land under the ownership of the complainant having its Plot No. 3018/3212, recorder in Khatian No. 794, situated adjacent to the Bastu Land (house & homestead) of your petitioner, were uprooted on that days storm.
- 2) That the accused nos. 1 & 2, the neighbours of your petitioner then had been to the said plot and started cutting the branches of the trees so uprooted in logs and also started shifting those wooden logs to their residence most illegally and without the knowledge and consent of the complainant.
- 3) That subsequently thereafter the witness no. 2 i.e. the wife of your petitioner having come to learn about such illegal shifting rushed to the place of occurrence and requested the accused not to proceed with such act in violation of prevailing law of the land.
- 4) That hearing such request the accused no. 1 caught hold of the lock of hair of the witness no.2 and asked her to leave the place of occurrence but the witness no.2 naturally was not agreed to comply with such verdict which became the reason of annoy of the accused no.1 who then dashed the witness no.2 to the earth and she failed down the accused no.2 started dragging her catching hold of her apparel, the ill fated lady, the witness no.2 became next to nothing on and her modesty was thus outraged.
- 5) That meanwhile the accused no. 3 & 4 being armed with lathi reached the place of occurrence and started uttering that the accused no. 1 & 2 would have to take bath since they touched a lady belonging to Schedule Cast community and asked the accused no. 1

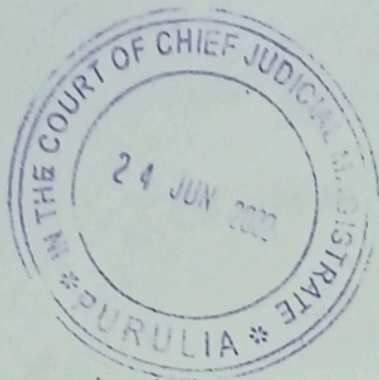

& 2 to return back to their house for having bath as within that period the illegal act of above mentioned shifting of wooden log was almost over and the accused no. 3 & 4 also declared that they would drive away the witness no.2 from the P.O. assaulting them with the Lathi in their hand.

- 6) That the accused no. 1 & 2 then started leaving the P.O. with filthy words on their lips aiming at the witness no. 2 as she was/is a lady of lower cast. The accused no.1 & 2 also spited on the witness no. 2 and started hurling that as they touched an untouchable lady belonging to schedule cast community they would have to take bath in such a stormy night of calamity.
- 7) That the accused no. 3 & 4 then with the Lathi in their hand started chasing the witness no. 2 addressing her 'Sali' and they also started holding out threats by saying that they would compell the witness no. 2 and her family to leave their locality known as 'Bamun Para' as her sub-cast is Bauri.
- 8) That the witness no. 2 then somehow or other managed to get rid of the clutches of those accused persons and to take shelter of their residence and also to get the entrance door locked with the help of hinge. Out of fear then on that date neither the witness no.2 nor any of her inmates went of their homestead.

It is pertinent to mention here that the witness no. 3 was at Burdwan at the relevant point of time for the sake of his job and while his sibling namely Sourav Bouri for the same purpose was at Hoogly and your petitioner was groaning in fever.

- 9) That however the witness no.3 on receipt of the incident in question over telephone returned back to his native place on the next date and prepared a letter of complaint as per the version and instruction of your petitioner and accompanied to Pancha P.S. but the officer on duty asked them to come two days later on pleas of business for law and order duty. But unfortunately thereafter though your petitioner time and again had been to the said P.S. he received no remedy, nor was he allowed to meet the O/C Pancha P.S. with a prayer for set the Law in motion. Lastly on 23.05.2022 your petitioner was intimated that since the dispute was centering around a civil problem no legal steps could be taken from their side and on that occasion he was rebuked when he prayed for having a visit to the O/C Pancha P.S. Your petitioner then under compelling circumstances sent the letter of complaint to the O/C Pancha P.S. but then to when no specific case was instituted he

brought the matter to the kind notice of the S.P. Purulia in writing on 09.06.2022 but unfortunately the District Police Administration still turned deaf ears to the same and no specific case has yet been started, though the persons belonging to schedule caste community must be prevented from all atrocities so committed against them with the help of special enactment.

10) That search and seizure is very much warranted in the instant case and your petitioner is a very poor and rustic person heaving no such annual income for incurring expenses of a complaint case.

In light of the above it is therefore prayed that Your Honour may graciously be pleased to forward the instant petition of complaint to the O/C of Pancha P.S. with a direction upon him to investigate into the case treating the same as F.I.R under the provisions contemplated under section 156 (3) Cr.P Code.
