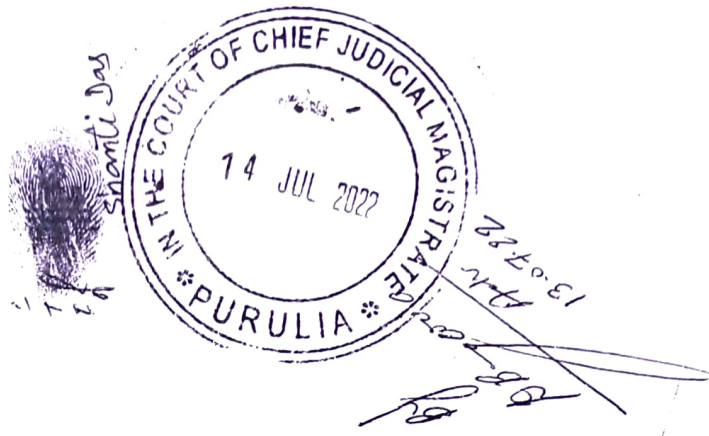
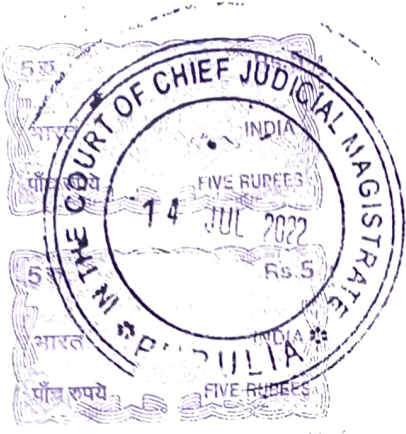

- 1) That, the complainant is the permanent resident of the above noted address.
- 2) That, on 09/06/2022 at about 03 to 04.00 P.M when the complainant was alone in her residential house at that time the accused persons who are the same villagers, suddenly attacked upon the complainant with rod, lathi and other deadly weapons by saying that to leave the place otherwise they will murder her.
- 3) That, the accused persons assaulted the complainant and due to such incident the complainant received grievous

injuries over her body and her right hand figure was cut down, the accused persons abused her and tore the saree and blouse and other wearing apparels and assaulted in her forehead as a result she become senseless.

- 4) That, the son of the complainant Kamal Das with the help of the local persons admitted the complainant at Deben Mahata Govt. medical college & hospital at Purulia and she was treated her by the doctors, at the time of the incident said Kamal Das tried to save the complainant and the accused persons also assaulted Kamal Das.
- 5) That, the complainant was discharged from the hospital on 12/06/2022 and the documents are attached with the petition.
- 6) That, the complainant went to the Purulia Sadar police station with her son but the police said that the accused lodged the F.I.R against Kamal Das and others and so the police arrested Kamal Das.
- 7) That, the complainant file the petition before the S.P at Purulia on 14/06/2022 but no action or F.I.R was lodged against the accused persons till date.
- 8) That, the complainant is filling the Xerox copies of the letter which was informed to the Superintendent of police, treatment ticket etc.
- 9) That, the accused persons are very dangerous in nature and they are threatening the complainant with dire consequences by saying not to depose elsewhere against him otherwise they will murder her, so there is every chance of loss of life of the complainant, and the accused persons are very adamant to cause hurt etc.

Hence it is prayed that your Honour may graciously be pleased to sent the complaint to officer-in-charge at Purulia(T) to treat the same as F.I.R and to investigate the matter U/S 156(3) Cr.P.C.
