Sir,

In producing here with one arrested accused person Chandramohon Gorai (24 yrs) S/O Molina Gorai of vill Herodih, P.S.-Arsha Dist-Purulia along with following seized articles.

- 1) 10 bottle of Officer Choice, 375 ML each bottle & Rs- 250/- each bottle
- 2) 04 bottle of Officer Choice, 180 ML each bottle & Rs- 130/- each bottle
- 3) 04 bottle of McDowell's No. 1 RUM, 180 ML each bottle & Rs- 140/- each bottle
(One bottle taken out of the above as sample packed, labeled and sealed with sealing wax)
- 4) One white colour plastic container containing approx 10 ltrs. of ID liquor.
(Approx 500 ml taken out from of the above container as sample packed with sealing wax)

I, ASI Tapan Kr. Mahata of Arsha PS do hereby lodge a written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that today i.e 06.09.22 at about 05.15 hrs during my Spl. raid duty at Arsha PS area, receive source information over telephone that the above noted accused has been selling ID liquor in his shop at Herodih village. On receiving the source information I communicated with O/C Arsha PS over telephone and as per his direction I along with C/- 146 Maheswar Singh Sardar and C/- 109 Surjatapa Dolai both of Arsha PS rushed to the shop of above noted suspected person to work out the information vide Arsha PS C.C. No. 1807/22 dtd. 06.09.22. Reaching at Herodih village at about 06.05 hrs we fixed-up in the shop of Chandramohon Gorai (24 yrs) S/O Molinda Gorai of vill Herodih, P.S.-Arsha Dist-Purulia and found that (i) 10 bottle of Officer Choice, 375 ML each bottle & Rs- 250/- each bottle (ii) 04 bottle of Officer Choice, 180 ML each bottle & Rs- 130/- each bottle (iii) 04 bottle of McDowell's No. 1 RUM, 180 ML each bottle & Rs- 140/- each bottle and (iv) One white colour plastic container containing approx 10 ltrs. of ID liquor as sell proceed. There was one person inside that shop who, seeing the police party, had made a deliberate attempt to flee-away. but we were able to apprehended the above noted accused person who was selling foreign liquor and I.D Liquor which he use to sell clandestinely to make his profit. On demand he failed to produce any valid documents in support of selling foreign liquor and I.D Liquor. Accordingly, I seized all those articles after preparing a proper seizure list and put label on all the seized articles from his exclusive possession in presence of witnesses and properly sealed and labeled duly signed by the accused person and witnesses and one bottle of that seizure was taken as sample which was also duly labeled and approx 500 ml taken from the white colour plastic container as sample packed with sealing wax with label. It took time from 06.25 hrs. to 06.45 hrs. During interrogation he confessed his guilt. Therefore, I arrested him at 06.55 hrs after observing all the formalities issuing memo of arrest.

Under the above circumstances I, therefore, pray that a specific case u/s 46 (A)(c) of The Bengal Excise Act may kindly be registered against said Chandramohon Gorai (24 yrs) S/O Molinda Gorai of vill Herodih, P.S.-Arsha Dist-Purulia and also for arranging its investigation.
