The complainant above named most respectfully Showeth: -

- 1. That the complainant is a law-abiding citizen of India. The complainant no.- 1 is of the age 77 years and the complainant no.- 2 is the son of the complainant no.- 1. Both are the resident of Chaukuniya Village, P.O.- Nadiha, P.S.- Para, Dist.- Purulia (W.B.), Pin. –723136.
- 2. That the accused above named is the neighbour of the complainant. Both houses are situated near each other.
- 3. That on 22/07/22 the complainant made a written complaint at Para P.S. and again on 27/07/22 a verbal complaint was made before the same Police Station against the above-mentioned accused, for criminal trespass in complainant's property. But no such action was taken by the police.
- 4. That on 27/07/22 when the accused broke the boundary wall of the complainant and while objecting to the act of the accused, complainant Sadimoni Ansari was physically attacked by the accused.

- 5. That the complainant Sadimoni Ansari who aged about 77 years, was not only beaten by the accused rather the accused used their force through hands by pressing the neck of Sadimoni Ansari.
- 6. That on 02/08/22 again the accused(s) namely Alimuddin and Azimuddin Ansari started using slangs and suddenly entered into the premises of the complainant and started beatingSadimoni Ansari and his son Lukman Ansari for no reason.
- 7. That the accused then forcefully took away approximately 15 to 20 ripen bamboos from the complainant's premises.
- 8. That the accused also criminally intimidate both complainants for dire consequences in case the complainant ever objected or made a complaint or report the matter to the police.
- 9. That the complainant again went to Para P.S. but the report in this matter was lodged by Para P.S. and no such action was taken.
- 10. That on the same day after the above-mentioned incident and after rejection by the Para police the complainant first went to Purulia Devan MahatoHospital and had a treatment of the physical injury.
- 11. That thereafter the complainant went to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia and lodged the said complaint.
- 12. That the copy of the police complaint made to Para P.S. on 22/07/22 and the medical certificate issued by the Purulia Devan Mahato Hospital and the complaint made to Superintendent of Police are all being attached with this petition.
- 13. That even after two weeks no such action has been so far taken against the accused.
- 14. That the accused are criminal in nature and of quarrelling mind. The neighbours in the locality have witnessed the above-mentioned incidents since long.
- 15. That under this situation and circumstances the complainant prays for legal action against all the accused(s).

PRAYER: -

In view of aforesaid submission made hereand in the interest of the Justice, it is therefore most respectfully prayed that these Honorable court may graciously be pleased to: -

- i. Register the present complaint by the complainant.
- ii. Take cognizance of the offences, as the contents per se amounts to commission of offences as indicated above.
