Sir,

On 14/11/2022 at about 3.00 P.m. villagers of Bandhughutu, Barwajorra,

Dulgubera revenue village under the banner of Bandhughutu, Barwajorra
Dulgubera Gram Sabha, the legality of which is questionable in terms of
the provisions of Forest Rights Act, 2006 and rules made there under
gathered at Bomni Falls Ecotourism area under Bagmundi Beat of
Bagmundi Forest Range. All of them were carrying weapons. The
members of the said self proclaimed illegal gram Sabha attacked
Forest officers and staffs with weapons while they were performing Govt.
duty with a motive to murder. Despite the presence of police several
Forest officers and staffs have sustained grievous injury (List of medical
report encl^d) due to physical assault by the mob. They have forcefully
taken illegal control of Bomni Falls Ecotourism area which is a Govt.
property by installing board of the said illegal Gram Sabha at the
entrance gate of Bomni Falls Area. Also they have locked the ticket
Counter of the said ecotourism site announcing that ticketing will be
introduced from tomorrow by the said self proclaimed Gram Sabha.
The entire mob was led by ① Shyam Sundar Mandi, ② Nakul Boskey,
③ Rajen Tudu, ④ Rajeshwar Tudu, ⑤ Suspendar Chare, ⑥ Super-
Hembram, ⑦ Dhisen Chare, ⑧ Jyotilal Hansda, ⑨ Gulam Musmu,
⑩ ehumaram Hansda, ⑪ Sushil Musmu and others villagers. Further,
Smt. Jharna Acharjee instigated the mob, to forcefully acquire
Govt. property and to assault Forest Dept. officers and staffs.

These for, you are requested to immediately lodge F.I.R.
against the above mentioned persons and other villagers who
have assaulted public servants, you are also requested to take
(over leaf)

action to protect the said Govt. property ~~up~~ from illegal acquisition.


