Sir,

In producing here with 03 (three) arrested accused persons namely (1) Godadhar Gorain (62 yrs) S/o-Late Muchiram Gorain (2) Gangadhar Gorain (50 yrs) S/o-Bhukhal Gorain both of Vill-Sijua PS-Pindrajora Dist-Bokaro (JKD) (3) Karamchand Gorain (37 yrs) S/o-Renghu Gorain of Vill-Kashijharia PS-Pindrajora Dist-Bokaro (JKD) along with seized articles i.e. 05 (five) Bicycle loaded with approx 3.2 quintal steam coal each Bicycle (Total-16 Quintal approx) as per seizure list and submitting a written complaint against the Bicycle rider, to the effect that today i.e. 21/11/2022 myself along with C/-997 Rajkumar Bauri, C/-1358 Sanjib Patra & NVF/-1011 Ishan Mandal all of Joypur PS Dist-Purulia were performing Day Mobile duty at PS area vide CC No-3994/22 Dated-21/11/2022. During mobile duty at about 13:25 hrs received credible source information that 05 Bicycle loaded coal stream was coming from Chandankiyari under Jharkhand State side towards Manakchita Village under Joypur PS. After receiving source information, I informed the matter to IC Joypur PS and as per your kind direction we proceeded to work out the information. We stop the 05 (five) Bicycle loaded with coal and found that approx 3.2 quintal steam coal by each bicycle they carrying with their bicycle near Manakchita village more. On seeing Police persons, they tried to fled away, after hot chase we able to apprehended 03 persons and 02 persons fled away. On being asked they disclosed their name and address as noted above. On interrogation they stated that they will sell illegal coal to the local people at Chasmore under Joypur PS. On demand they failed to produce any valid papers in respect of possessing selling of steam coal. So it is reasonable to believe that the bicycle riders collected the said coal either by theft or by any other fraudulent means from anywhere and transporting the same to earn money for wrongful gains. As such, there is every reason to believe that the bi-cycle transporting steam coal illegally. So I seized the same under proper seizure list in between 14:15 hrs to 14:45 hrs & label duly signed by witnesses after taking sample of 01 kg steam coal from each bicycle. During further interrogation they confessed their guilt as such I arrested them today 21/11/2022 at 14:50 hrs to 15:05 hrs as the accused persons is liable for prosecution U/S-379/411/414 IPC.

I therefore pray before you, kindly lodge an FIR against the rider of the bicycle namely 1) Godadhar Gorain (62 yrs) S/o-Late Muchiram Gorain (2) Gangadhar Gorain (50 yrs) S/o-Bhukhal Gorain both of Vill-Sijua PS-Pindrajora Dist-Bokaro (JKD) (3) Karamchand Gorain (37 yrs) S/o-Renghu Gorain of Vill-Kashijharia PS-Pindrajora Dist-Bokaro (JKD) as per law and arrange for its investigation.
