**An Application on behalf of the
Petitioner/Complainant,**

Most respectfully sheweth:-

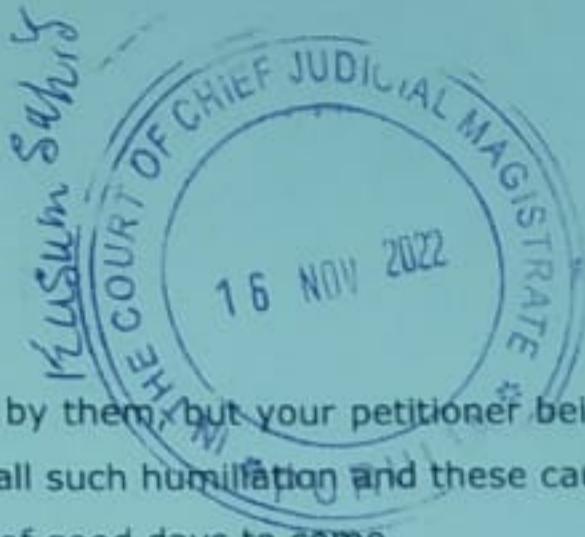
- 1) That the petitioner/complainant is the legally wedded wife of the accused no.1.
- 2) That their marriage was solemnised on 09.06.2019 corresponding to 25th day of Jaistha 1426 B.S. The said marriage was settled through negotiation and solemnized in accordance with the Hindu customary rites prevailing in the Hari (Sahis) Community at the father's house of the petitioner so situated at Vill-Dumkadih, P.O.-Darodih, P.S.-Tamna, and Dist.-Purulia and within the jurisdiction of Your Honour's Court.
- 3) That although the father of the petitioner/complainant is a day labour, he by way of borrowing money from his friends and relatives procured money to meet up the demand of Rs.55,000/- (Fifty Five Thousand) only so made on the side of the accused persons no. 1 to 9 at the time of settlement of the marriage between the petitioner and the accused no.1, the father of your petitioner also had to give a sum of Rs.30,000/- (Thirty Thousand) for conveyance, gold & Silver ornaments including a Necklace, a pair of silver 'Payel', were given to the petitioner by her father at the time of the marriage in question. Besides the accused no.1 was given a silver chain by the father of the petitioner towards ceremony of his Ashirbad. That apart the father of the petitioner was also compelled to give Stridhan properties to his daughter like a Almirah, Divan, Bed & Beddings, and different utensils made of steel, brass, bell metal, etc. pursuant to the demand made by the accused persons no. 1 to 9.
- 4) That after her marriage the petitioner on 10.06.2019 corresponding to 26th Jaistha had stepped into the threshold of her matrimonial house at Vill- Chipida, P.O.- Chitora, P.S.-Tamna, and Dist.- Purulia and within the jurisdiction of Your Honour's Court with lot of hopes and dreams locked into her heart towards leading a happy conjugal life in the joint/shared household properties and started living there at with the accused person no.1 as husband and wife amidst other in laws and in course there of the marriage was consummated.

- 5) That during the introductory days the petitioner's stay at her matrimonial house the accused no.1 used to show longings towards her and the rest of the inmates also used to shower love and affection towards her but the same was a transitory phenomenon and did not last long.
- 6) That after one month from the date of marriage in question the petitioner observed a radical change in the behavior of the accused persons no. 1 to 9.
- 7) That the accused persons no. 1 to 9 started saying that the Stridhan properties of the petitioner and the gifts so offered to the accused person no.1 by the father of the petitioner was not upto the mark. They all especially the accused no.1 thereafter used to ask the petitioner for bringing money from her father and on discloser of the inability of your petitioner's father towards giving additional dowry, she used to be subjected to persistent torture, both physical and mental.
- 8) That the accused no.1 in connivance with his elder brother Gurupada Sahis, sister-in-law (Boudi) Pati Sahis, and parents Fagu Sahis and Sarala Sahis respectively started picking up quarrel with the petitioner often even on any flimsy pleas and pretexts till mid night. The petitioner's sister-in-law (Nanad) one Gita Sahis used to add fuel to the fire on her every visit to her father's house i.e. the shared household of your petitioner.
- 9) That the petitioner had been saddled with the liability of doing house-chores, but even on the slightest latches and lapses on her part in doing the same she was subjected to utter humiliation and assault by her husband and other in laws. Her husband used to insult her saying that she was really a mismatch for him as well as for his family both in consideration of her countenance and financial status of her family. The accused person no.1 also almost every day used to inflict assault upon the petitioner, once he dashed her head with the wall for putting her life to an end, but still then your petitioner digested the same since she would like to have a happy conjugal life and thus to conceal the overt act of the accused no. 1. Your petitioner even had to face the bitter experience of spending nights in starvation during her stay at her in laws house, too. She also used to be taunted of and on as an awkward



looking ominous lady by them, but your petitioner being an ideal Hindu wife used to swallow all such humiliation and these caustic and sarcastic comments with hope of good days to come.

- 10) That as the days roll on the torture upon the petitioner so meted out to her by the accused person no. 1 to 9 was on rise.
- 11) That she brooked all such torture in anticipation of prospective happiness, but the accused person no. 1 to 9 did not mend himself.
- 12) That the petitioner/complainant also had to receive fists and blows & kicks from the accused persons no. 1 to 9, more over she even spent a number of nights without meal thereat her in-laws place. During her stay there at in her matrimonial house at the time of her falling ill she was asked to be treated medically at the cost of her father. Your petitioner then was reluctantly compelled to bring all these scenario to the notice of her parents, consequently when her parents had been to her in-laws house the accused person no.1 to 9 started hurling abusive language aiming at her parents and let her parents know that if they would like to keep their daughter in her matrimonial house any further, they would have to hand over a sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- (one Lakh) to the accused person no. 1 to 9 and when the parents of your petitioner disclosing their in ability prayed for some time the accused person no. 1 & 2 caught hold of their neck and dashed them & drove them out of their house. The accused no.3 also forced your petitioner out from her shared household property on that occasion. The petitioner also approached before the Kalyan family counseling center for having a happy conjugal life, but that too was of no good.
- 13) That the accused no.1 also often used to say that the father of the petitioner should always remain grateful and obliged to him and his parents since he, being an established professional and a reputed person having sufficient money, married the daughter of a needy labour.
- 14) That your petitioner on 15.07.2022 corresponding to 13th day of Ashar received an information that the accused person no.1 has been given in marriage for second time at Berada Shiv Mandir with the accused no.10, happens to be the daughter of accused no. 11. On receipt of such information your petitioner along with her parents had

been to her in-laws place where the accused persons firstly restrained them from entering into the house and homestead but your petitioner continued requesting with folded hand when the accused no. 1 and 10 forcibly placing him in a room left the room under lock and key and thereafter the accused no. 1 along with the other co-accused persons asked the accused no.1 to put your petitioner's life to an end. The accused no.1 then entering into the said room suddenly started pressing the face of your petitioner with a pillow with an intention to kill her, but when your petitioner resultantly started groaning her parents called the neighbouring people and seeing them to come the accused no.1 escaped there from. Your petitioner then returned back to her father's place with her parents under compelling circumstances.

- 15) That at the time your petitioner's departure there from the accused no.4 informed her loudly that since he is a Civic Volunteer no specific case is going to be instituted against the accused person by the police personnel of any P.S. of the district.
- 16) That the complainant had been to the Purulia Sadar Women P.S. on 20.07.2022 with a written complainant depicting inter alia all the real scenario what happened wrongfully upon her with a prayer for setting the Law in motion, but the officer on duty asked her to come on the following month with an excuse that they are busy in Law & Order duty. There after your petitioner time and again had been to the said P.S. but neither her complaint was received nor she was permitted to meet the O/C concerned.
- 17) That your petitioner then sent her letter of complaint under registered cover with A/D on 29.09.2022 addressing the O/C Purulia Sadar Women P.S. but then too the addressee refused to accept the letter of complainant.
- 18) That due to such inaction on the part of the police personnel of the concerned P.S. your petitioner informed the matter in writing to S.P Purulia on 12.10.2022, but unfortunately the District Police Administration still turned deaf ears to the same and no specific case has yet been instituted.

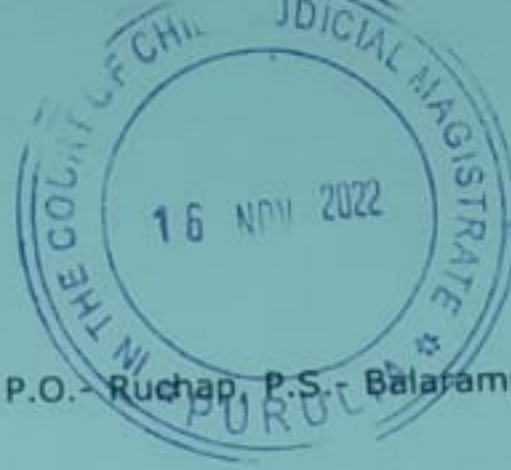
