Sir,

In producing herewith the 06(Six) accused persons namely (1) Hemanta Mahato (29 Yrs), S/O- Arjun Mahato of Vill- Dhanudih, (2) Sahebram Baskey (25 Yrs), S/O- Lt. Lerhu Baskey of Vill- Chirugora, (3) Naresh Chandra Mahato, S/O- Lt. Gokul Bihari Mahato of Vill- Dhanudih, (4) Sraban Mahato (45 Yrs), S/O- Mangal Mahato of Vill- Srirampur, (5) Jagadish Kumar (25 Yrs), S/O- Rajkishor Kumar of Vill- Duarsini, (6) Sahadeb Mahato (40 Yrs), S/O- Lt. Abhinash Mahato of Vill- Dhanudih and all are of PS- Baghmundi, Dist- Purulia along with seized articles (1) Ten(10) pieces of stone, (2) 6 pieces of Lathi, (3) 2 pieces of Iron stick, (4) One broken guardrail which were seized under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses.

I ASI Dinesh Rajak, of Baghmundi P.S do here by lodge complain against accused persons namely (1) Hemanta Mahato (29 Yrs), S/O- Arjun Mahato of Vill- Dhanudih, (2) Sahebram Baskey (25 Yrs), S/O- Lt. Lerhu Baskey of Vill- Chirugora, (3) Naresh Chandra Mahato, S/O- Lt. Gokul Bihari Mahato of Vill- Dhanudih, (4) Sraban Mahato (45 Yrs), S/O- Mangal Mahato of Vill- Srirampur, (5) Jagadish Kumar (25 Yrs), S/O- Rajkishor Kumar of Vill- Duarsini, (6) Sahadeb Mahato (40 Yrs), S/O- Lt. Abhinash Mahato of Vill- Dhanudih, (7) Sraban Soren, S/O- Lokhai Soren of Vill-Bandhudih and all are of PS- Baghmundi, Dist-Puurlia (Sl No- 1-6 arrested and Sl no- 7 not arrested) along with 200/250 others resident of Matha GP area under Baghmundi PS to the fact that on 30.12.2022 at about 14.05 hrs received information from Matha GP area that a huge unlawful gathering being armed with deadly weapon assembled on SH4 (Baghmundi- Balarampur Road) near at Matha Panchayet Office under Baghmundi PS area. Being directed by OC Baghmundi PS myself along with force who were deployed for RT Mobile duty vide CC No. 2090, Dtd: 30.12.2022 & corresponding GDE No- 1382, dtd- 30.12.2022 to verify the information to avoid any untoward incident. Myself along with force arrived near Matha GP on SH4 area and it is found that 350/400 people assembled with Iron rod, lathi, bricks, stone etc on SH4 road near at Matha GP and obstructed the Baghmundi- Balarampur main road of SH4 causing annoyance to the local public and the tourist who were travelling a long distance. Accordingly, officers and force went to the spot to tackle the situation. It was found that members were very much excited and were creating hallah and uttering slang languages to create serious Law and Order situation over the issue of 'Awas yojana'. Since it was an issue of 'Awas yojana', the matter was conveyed to the BDO Baghmundi and after a while the

BDO Baghmundi also reached the PO. But the agitated mob did not pay any heed towards police and BDO. Even they became more violent and they were obstructing the running vehicles on SH4 road. The officers and force tried to pacify but the mob was very much adamant and furious. They started to attack the on duty police officer and force at the spot. After that they started to pelt stones/brick bats etc aiming to the police and BDO, hence, they have committed the offence to obstruct the public servant to perform their Govt. duty. Officers and forces were also trying to their level best to maintain peace but all the efforts ended in vain. Rather they became extremely out of control and also ransacked the on road police guardrails. BDO Baghmundi and the Police party requested them to disperse from the spot on several occasion. But the agitated mob did not bother that. The agitated mob then started pelting stones. Finding no other alternatives, we had to use minimum force by lathi to disperse the agitated mob. However we could be able to detain Six (06) persons from the spot. On being asked they disclosed their name and address as noted above. I arrested the above noted persons after maintaining all formalities and guidelines regarding arrest. I offered them for medical treatment but they refused. I also seized (1) Ten(10) pieces of stone, (2) 6 pieces of Lathi, (3) 2 pieces of Iron stick, (4) One broken guardrail from the PO under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses. During preliminary stage it has been found that the above noted accused persons along with some others have conspired the road blockade misleading the local villagers over 'Awas yojana' in order to cause nuisance.

Under the fact and circumstances I therefore pray before you a specific case may kindly be started against the said accused persons under proper section of law and arrange its investigation.
