




The above name complainant begs to state as follows:

- 1) That the complainant and the accused persons are the permanent resident of village- village Pathraghata, P.S. Barabazar, Dist- Purulia.
- 2) That the complainant is a small cultivator and is a poor person and he has inherited a very little quantity of cultivable land and he used to cultivate those lands since the time of his father and after death of his father he is inheriting all those landed property including the present related lands which is situated at mouza Pathraghata, under P.S. Barabazar, recorded as J.L. No. 76, Plot no. 945,1219,1220 etc.




- 3) That like previous years, this last rainy season the complainant cultivated those lands and the paddy were grown well and is ready for harvesting.
- 4) That on the date of incident i.e. on 06/11/2022 corresponding to 19th Agrahan 1429 B.S. at about 10:00 am the above noted accused persons all on a sudden armed with lati, tangi etc. criminally trespassed in the land over which the complainant growing paddy and the accused persons cut and remove those paddy valued of those paddy with straw will be Rs. 22,000/- approximately.

Seeing such illegal activities on the part of the above noted accused persons, the complainant protested, then the accused persons abuse the complainant in filthy languages and assaulted him and threatened him by showing Tangi and putting the said weapon on his neck, out of fear the complainant could not raise objection.



It is very pertinent to point out that that the complainant is possessing the land in question, but the above noted accused persons have no manner of right or possession over any portion thereof.

- 5) That the above noted accused persons still threatening the complainant and his family members by giving out that if the complainant dare to report the incident before any one in that case the accused persons will murder the complainant and will not allow him and his family members to stay in the village. Accordingly the complainant along with his family members are passing their days in a very panic stricken condition.
- 6) That the accused persons committed various offences punishable under the Indian penal code for which they are deserved to be punished under the law.
- 7) That the matter was reported to the Officer-in-charge Barabazar P.S. against the accused persons but the said



Officer-in-charge did not taken any legal action then the complainant lodged another complaint to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia but with same fate, then the complainant is under compelling circumstances is filing this complaint before the Ld. Court for appropriate reliefs under the law.

It is therefore, prayed that your honour may be pleased to sent the petition of complaint to the Officer-in-charge Barabazar P.S. for treating the same as FIR under section 156(3) for investigation .
