Respected Sir,

In producing here with 03(three) arrested accused persons namely (1)Bharatha Rajesh(46),s/o-Krishna Murthy of 9.119 Opp Bijaya Taukies PS-Nandigam, Dist-Krishna Andhra Pradesh 521185, (2) Bijay Yadav(30),s/o-Lakhpat Yadav of Vill+PO-Chopnadih, PS-Markacho. Dist-Kodarma, Jharkhand, (3)Asif Khan(26),s/o-Masuk Khan of Area more Matkuria road, Dhanbad Sadar, Jharkhand along with 03 (three) seized vehicles Nos (1) One truck(12 wheeler) having regd no-AP39UC/8589 loaded with aprox 24 Ton Coal, (2) One truck(14 wheeler) having Regd no-JH09AX/5400 loaded with approx 30 Ton Coal seems to be coke coal (3) One truck having no-JH10BV8003 loaded with aprpx 30 Ton coal, seems to be steam coal and also taken sample of 05 kg coal from each truck to the effect that I SI Basudev Acharya along with C/624-Pradip Chakraborty, C/2735-Soumen Nayak, C/178-Tulsi Mahato, CD/535-Laxmi Kanta Bangal , all are of Purulia (M)PS were engaged in Naka duty at Ghonga on Purulia-Chandankeyari road near Ghonga Petrol pump vide Purulia(M)PS CC No-4180/22 Dtd-29.11.2022 and PS GDE No-1448 Dtd-29.11.2022 and at about 22.25 hrs stopped that three(03) vehicles loaded with illegal coal coming from Chandankeyari side(Jharkhand).Contacted with my I/C and informed the matter and as per kind order and on demand they failed to produce any valid documents in respect of loaded coal. On preliminary enquiry it could be learnt that they with conspiracy of owners of said trucks & others procured the said illegal coal from different places and were transporting the same in a clandestine manner to another district/state. So, it is reasonable to believe that they were transporting the coal illegally after procuring. Accordingly I seized the above noted vehicles loaded with coal under proper seizure list duly signed by the accompanied Police persons in between 22.45 hrs & 23.10 hrs as there was no availability of any local person as at the odd hours of night at the place of Naka, as such I could not collect the signature of the local people in all seizure list and during seizure I had taken 05 Kg coal from each truck as sample. After that I arrested them at 23.15 hrs , 23.25 hrs and 23.35 hrs after observing all formalities regarding arrest. After that we made proper arrangement and brought the vehicles loaded with coal at PS to keep at PS compound.

Therefore, I pray that a specific case may kindly be registered against above noted three (03) arrested accused persons (drivers) and owners of the 03 (three) seized vehicles and other associates under proper section of law.
