Respected Sir,

In producing here with 03(three) arrested accused persons namely (1)Md Khalid(22), s/o-Muslim Osta of Dubra, PS-Para, Dist-Purulia, driver of seized vehicle no- WB55A/7456 , (02)Rahamat Ansary(24), s/o-Hussain Ansary of Hodla, PS-Raghunathpur, Dist-Purulia, driver of seized vehicle no- WB55A/6746 (03) Asif Ansary (20), s/o-Daud Ansary of vill-Jamua, PS-Raghunathpur, Dist-Purulia, driver of seized vehicle no- WB55A/6651 along with 03 (three) seized vehicles Nos (1) One truck having regd no-WB55A/6746 loaded with aprox 20 Ton Coal, seems to be steam coal (2) One truck having Regd no-WB55A/7456 loaded with approx 20 Ton Coal,seems to be steam coal (3) One truck having no-WB55A/6651 loaded with aprpx 20 Ton coal,seems to be steam coal and also taken sample of 05 kg coal from each truck to the effect that I ASI Ajay Mukhopadhyay along with C/611-Jitendranath Pathak, HG/1896-Ambarish Kumar, all are of Purulia (M)PS were engaged in Naka duty at Bhangra Bat-tola more on Purulia-Bankura road(NH60A) vide Purulia(M)PS CC No-4214/22 Dtd-02.12.2022 and PS GDE No-84 Dtd-02.12.2022 and at about 15.15 hrs stopped three(03) vehicles loaded with coal coming from Chharrah-Aerodrum side. I contacted with my I/C and informed the matter and as per kind order I interrogated three drivers noted above and on demand they failed to produce any valid documents in respect of loaded coal. On preliminary enquiry it could be learnt that they with conspiracy of owners of said trucks & others procured the said illegal coal from different places and were transporting the same in a clandestine manner to another district/state wrongful gain. So, it is reasonable to believe that they were transporting the coal illegally after procuring by means of theft. Accordingly I seized the above noted vehicles loaded with coal under proper seizure list duly signed by the accompanied Police persons in between 15.45 hrs and 16.25 hrs as there was no availability of any local person, as such I could not collect the signature of the local people in all seizure list and during seizure I had taken 05 Kg coal from each truck as sample. After that I arrested them at 16.35 hrs, 16.45 hrs and 16.55 hrs after observing all formalities regarding arrest. After that we brought the said three-seized vehicles loaded with coal at PS after proper arrangement and kept at PS campus.

Therefore, I pray that a specific case may kindly be registered against above noted three (03) arrested accused persons (drivers) and owners of the 03 (three) seized vehicles and other associates under proper section of law.
