

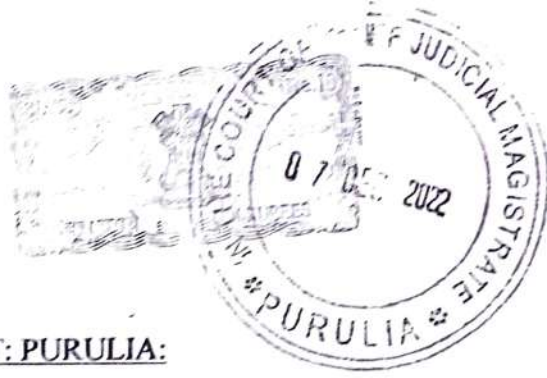

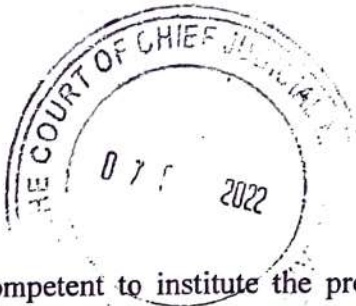

**MOST RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:-**

01) That the complainant is a company within the meaning of its term under the Companies Act, 1956 and is having its registered office at 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Global Vision, Electronic Sadan-II, MIDC TTC Industrial Area, Mahape, Navi Mumbai, 400710, Maharashtra and Circle Office at 7<sup>th</sup> Floor, Shaila Tower, Plot – J1/16, Block- EP & GP, Sector- V, Saltlake, West Bengal, PIN – 700091 and is engaged in the business of installation and maintenance of passive infrastructure/Telecom Towers for the licensed telecom operators of the Country in pursuance of the Registration Certificate issued by the Department of Telecommunications, Ministry of Communications and I.T., Government of India.

02) That this present complaint case is filed through its authorized signatory namely Mr. Anup Kumar Saha, son of Late Akul Chandra Saha presently posted and/or working as the Manager, Law & Order and duly authorized by Complainant Company through a Letter of Authority dated





14<sup>th</sup> September, 2021 and, therefore competent to institute the present proceeding on behalf of the Complainant Company.

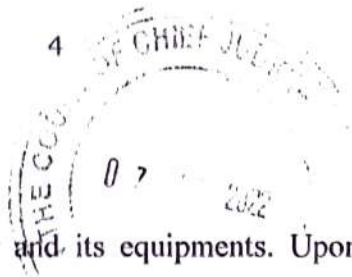

03) That a Mobile Tower, viz. a Telecom Tower of “**Ground Based Tower**” in category along with its all ancillary equipments were installed at the Land of Sri Banka Behari Das, Sri Trivanga Mohan Das and Sri Alanga Mohan Das, all sons of Late Ram Gopal Das, located at Dhabghata, near Over Bridge (Bankura Road), Mouza- Purulia, comprised in Dag No. 3077, Khatian No. 3889, Touzi No. 29, P.O. Purulia, P.S. Purulia, District- Purulia, West Bengal (hereinafter referred as to the said “**Telecom Site / Demise Premises**”) after entering into a Lease Deed dated 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2009 (hereinafter be referred as the said ‘**Agreement**’) by your Petitioner Company as entered with said Sri Banka Behari Das, Sri Trivanga Mohan Das and Sri Alanga Mohan Das, all sons of Late Ram Gopal Das.

Photocopies of the aforesaid Agreement is annexed herewith as **Annexure – ‘A’** to this complaint petition.

04) That since 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2009 your Petitioner Company has been in lawful possession over the Schedule mentioned properties viz. the said worthy installed Ground Based Tower with its fitted all allied equipments (the ‘assets’) at the said telecom site and paid rent to the Landlord of the said leased land regularly till its operation.

05) That the representative of the complainant company had visited the aforesaid premises on 28<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 for a routine survey and was shocked to find that the said entire mobile tower and its ancillary equipments which includes the entire Mobile Tower, SMPS, Shelter, Diesel Generator, Stabiliser, Air- Conditioner, along with allied Electrical Fittings and cables etc., (hereinafter referred to as “**Dismantled/Stolen Assets**”) were missing altogether viz. theft from the demises premises viz. from the said Telecom Site after unauthorized



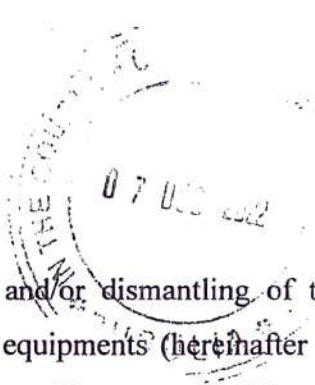
dismantling of the said Tower and its equipments. Upon enquiry the representative of the complainant company came to know that the above mentioned Assets worth its depreciated value of **Rs. 22,24,926/-** (Rupees Twenty Two Lakhs Twenty Five Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty Six only) were dismantled and removed from the demise premises without consent and knowledge of the complainant company who owned the same.

**06)** Your Petitioner submits further that being informed about the aforesaid irreparable loss, the Company had sent its representative again at the said site on 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2022, and again on 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2022, and finally on 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2022 and thereby got assured and/or ensured that the said Telecom Tower along with the equipments as mentioned below at the Annexure – I have been Stolen indeed after it was fully dismantled and removed from the said site without the consent and knowledge of the Petitioner Company. While asking by the representative of your Petitioner Company, the family members of the said Landlords have not and/or could not divulged any fact and hence it is understood that the said act of dismantling the Assets and finally to theft of Assets is caused by some unknown miscreant or miscreants. That the said act of theft of the said valuable tower and its allied equipments was duly informed in person by the Authorised Signatory hereof to the concerned Purulia Police Station on 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2022 itself. But the said Police Station did not accept the said Written Complaint and did not act on the Written Complaint of this Complainant Company so far. Your petitioner craves leave of this Ld. Court to show the said written complaint during the time of hearing if permitted.

**07)** Your petitioner submits that the said Telecom Tower structure and its ancillary equipments are purely movable properties and can be dismantled and/or disassembled in part and can be moved out easily.

08) That due to this unlawful theft and/or dismantling of the said valuable movable Tower and its allied equipments (hereinafter be said 'assets') as installed at the said Telecom Site committed by accused unknown miscreant or miscreants, the Petitioner Company has faced and is facing huge financial loss and/or total deprivation. It is pertinent to mention that Petitioner Company has/had never intention to dismantle the said tower at the said Site nor company has authorized and/or consented to any third party for the same.

09) That finding no other alternative your petitioner send its Written Complaint by postal service, viz. Speed Post to the Officer-in-Charge of Purulia Police Station vide its written complaint dated 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 through Speed Post which was duly served at the said P.S. on 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 but till date no action has been taken against the accused person or persons in spite of the said Written Complaint dated 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 which was duly served at the office of Officer-in-Charge of Purulia Police Station on 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2022.

A copy of the said written complaint dated 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 and postal receipts along with the proof of delivery/ delivery confirmation by Indian Postal Department are annexed herewith and marked as **Annexure 'B'**.

10) Thereafter since no action was taken by the said Purulia Police Station, the complainant company has also approached the office of the Superintendent of Police, Purulia District Police through its written complaint dated 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 sent vide Speed Post of Indian Postal Service, stating the aforesaid facts and requested to issue direction to the concerned police officials to register FIR and investigate the matter but till date no steps has been taken. Said written complaint to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia District Police was served on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2022.

Photocopies of the said Written Complaint dated 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 and its track consignment of Indian Postal

Services are collectively enclosed herewith as **Annexure – 'C'**.

11) That your Petitioner states that since no action was taken by the said Office of the Superintendent of Police, Purulia District Police, after elapsed prolong time line, the complainant company has again informed about the said theft of its valued assets through its written complaint dated 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2022 sent vide Speed Post of Indian Postal Service, for a direction to the concerned Purulia police officials to register FIR and investigate the matter but till date no steps has been taken. Said second written complaint to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia District Police was served on 3<sup>rd</sup> December, 2022.

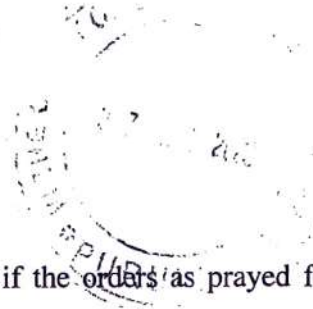
Photocopies of the said Written Complaint dated 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2022 and its track consignment of Indian Postal Services are collectively enclosed herewith as **Annexure – 'D'**.

12) That your petitioner submits that the said entire Ground Based Tower structure and its allied equipments which includes said entire Mobile Tower, SMPS, Shelter, Diesel Generator, Stabiliser, Air-Conditioner, along with allied Electrical Fittings and cables etc., all are purely movable properties and owned by your petitioner company and were installed and/or kept in the demised premises / telecom site of your petitioner, i.e. under possession of the petitioner and the accused person or persons hereof with a dishonest intention to harm your petitioner company have taken out of the possession of the petitioner from the said demised property, i.e. the site of your petitioner company without knowledge and consent of the petitioner company.

13) That in the facts and circumstances of the case it is evident that the accused person/ persons had committed the offences punishable under various provisions of the Indian Penal Code including theft and he/ they are liable to be punished for the same which falls well within the jurisdiction of this learned Court.
