Sir,

I, SI Sajal Kanti Panda along with force returned to PS and brought under seizure (i) 02 old rusted cycles (ii) 02 sacks having stuffed with steam coal is approx 0.3 Ton in each sack (iii) approx 0.3 Ton steam coal in total piled at the PO i.e. in a patch of jungle near Subarnarekha river at Brajapur village under proper seizure list and produced before your good self.

The fact in brief is that today (28/01/2023) I along with force namely i) RM/1485 Yogesh Rai (ii) RM/1516 Ganesh Chettri both of EFR 3rd Bn. Salua camp at Jhalda PS were performing Day mobile duty in PS area vide Jhalda P.S. GDE No- 1339 Dated- 28/01/2023 in consonance with Jhalda PS CC No- 301/23 Dated-28/01/2023. During my Day mobile duty, at about 12:35 hrs, I received credible tip off that some persons were carrying illegal steam coal by bicycles and unloading the same in a patch of jungle near Subarnarekha river at Brajapur village under Jhalda PS. Subsequently I, informed to you as well as to the duty officer and as per your direction I asked the duty officer to note the information down in the GDE Vide Jhalda PS GDE No 1351 Dated 28/01/2023 and I proceeded to the spot to work out the information. Consequently, we arrived at the spot at about 13:15 hrs and found that (i) 02 old rusted cycles (ii) 02 sacks having stuffed with steam coal is approx 0.3 Ton in each sack (iii) approx 03 Ton steam coal in total piled at the PO i.e. in a patch of jungle near Subarnarekha river at Brajapur village which were as identical as I received prior information. But seeing the Police Party, the persons involved in committing illegal carrying and unloading the steam coal, flee away leaving the said amount of coal at the spot. We tried to apprehend them but failed. We waited for reasonable time but none came to spot. During the endemic enquiry it came to reveal that Dilip Saw S/O Hiralal Saw of Mosina near school more, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia along with others was carrying and unloading the steam coal at the spot and the said Dilip Saw is the kingpin of this illegal act. It was ascertained that the those persons and others loaded the said steam coal from illegal coal mines from Jharkhand state in cahoots with the land owner by illegal mining and tried to sell the same to make profit by dishonestly and they had been running a clandestine business. So it is reasoned to belief that the said persons in cahoots with others procured the said steam coal from Jharkhand state by fraudulently means or theft by any means for transporting the same to run clandestine business. Ergo, I seized the following articles (i) 02 old rusted cycles (ii) 02 sacks having stuffed with steam coal is approx 0.3 Ton in each sack (iii) approx 0.3 Ton steam coal in total piled at the PO i.e. in a patch of jungle near Subarnarekha river at Brajapur village after preparing proper seizure list in presence of available witnesses duly signed by them. Thereafter, I brought the said seizure articles by arranging another goods vehicle to Jhalda PS compound.

Under the above facts and circumstances kindly take lawful action against the accd. person namely (i) Dilip Saw S/O Hiralal Saw of Mosina near school more, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia and others as they committed offence U/S- 379/411/414/120B of the IPC.
