Sir,

In producing here with the 02(two) arrested accused persons namely Sk Kader (38) S/O Sk Sader of village Paranchak PO- Joydeb kenduli PS- Ilambazar, District- Birbhum 2. Dil Mohammad (37) S/O Lt Sk Dhansad of village Rasikchak Po- Joydeb Kenduli PS Ilambazar District Birbhum along with seized vehicles (Hyva) bearing registration WB15C/4601 and WB15B/9604 loaded with approx 300 cft stone chips in each vehicle.

I beg to state that today i.e on 02.01.2023 I along with C/638 Lalchand Bag, C/336 Karick Ch Roy Vide Manbazar P.S C.C No 8117/23 and GDE No- 62 dt- 02.01.2023 were engaged in evening mobile duty. At 21:05 hrs received a credible source information that the above noted vehicles (Hyva) bearing registration No. WB15C/4601 and WB15B/9604 were transporting stone chips illegally and coming from Bankura side. Myself along with had been towards Pairachali bridge on Manbazar- Bankura road to work out the information. When we reached near Sri Durga filling centre (Petrol pump) on Manbazar – Bankura Road under Manbazar PS, Dist- Purulia, found the said vehicles were coming from Pairachali side. Seeing the police party, driver of the said vehicles (Hyva) tried to flee away keeping the vehicles on the road. We chased them and after a hot chase could be able to intercept drivers of both the vehicles. Then we searched the vehicles and found that the registration no. of vehicles are WB15C/4601 and WB15B/9604 and the vehicles are loaded with approx 300 (Three Hundred) cft stone chips in each vehicle. On asked both the drivers disclosed their identity as Sk Kader (38) S/O Sk Sader of village Paranchak PO- Joydeb kenduli PS Ilambazar, District Birbhum, driver of vehicle no WB15C/4601 and 2. Dil Mohammad (37) S/O Lt Sk Dhansad of village Rasikchak Po- Joydeb Kenduli PS Ilambazar District Birbhum, driver of vehicle no WB15B/9604. I asked them to produce valid documents in respect both the vehicles as well as stone chips loaded in it. But they failed to produce any valid documents in respect of vehicles as well as stone chips loaded in it. On asked the above noted drivers confessed their guilt and stated that they are transporting stone chips in such way since long. Hence there is every reason to believe that both the drivers namely Sk Kader (38) S/O Sk Sader of village Paranchak PO- Joydeb kenduli PS- Ilambazar, District- Birbhum 2. Dil Mohammad (37) S/O Lt Sk Dhansad of village Rasikchak Po- Joydeb Kenduli PS Ilambazar District Birbhum along with following seized vehicles (Hyva) bearing registration no. WB15C/4601 and WB15B/9604 loaded with approx 300 cft stone chips in each vehicle and owner of the above mentioned vehicles with ill motive are transporting stone chips illegally without any valid documents in support of carrying stone chips in a clandestine manner since few days and they are habitual in transportation of stone ships illegally by clandestine manner for their wrongful gain. Finding no other alternative I seized both the vehicles bearing regn No. WB15C/4601 and WB15B/9604 loaded with approx 300 cft stone chips in each vehicle under proper seizure list and arrested both the drivers namely Sk Kader (38) S/O Sk Sader of village Paranchak PO- Joydeb kenduli PS Ilambazar, District Birbhum, driver of vehicle no WB15C/4601 and 2. Dil Mohammad (37) S/O Lt Sk Dhansad of village Rasikchak Po- Joydeb Kenduli PS
