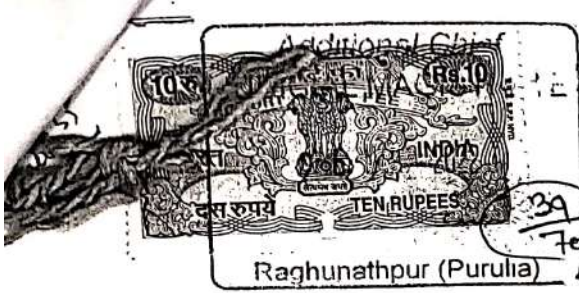

Most Respectfully Sheweth:-

1. That, Complainant happens to be a local resident of Traffic Colony, Railway Quarter no. L/18A, P.O & P.S- Adra, Dist- Purulia (W.B).
2. That, the marriage between the complainant and the accused person namely C. Tripathi S/O- Late. C. Gangarao was held on 24.04.2016 at Adra as per the Hindu Rites and Customs prevailing in their society.
3. That being neglected and tortured (Physically and mentally) by the accused person no.1 the complainant had to file a Misc. Case U/S-12 of the PWDV Act before the ACJM, Raghunathpur which was registered as Misc. Case no. 23 of 2019 and was transferred before the Ld. J.M (1st Court), Raghunathpur for trial and disposal. Notices were served in the accused person no.1 appeared in the case , submitted show cause and as filed by the Petitioner a petition for interim maintenance was allowed by the Ld. Court after hearing both the sides , where in the Ld. Court has been pleased to pass Rs. 8,000/- per month as interim maintenance .
4. That as the accused person no.1 did not obey the order passed by the Ld. Court and did not pay the interim maintenance amount, the complainant had to file two execution cases for executing the order passed by the Ld. Court and for recovery of the arrear maintenance amount, which were Registered as Misc. (Execution) case no. 18 of 2021 and Misc. (Execution) case no. 19 of 2021 before the Ld. J.M (1st Court), Raghunathpur.
5. That 05.11.2022 was the date fixed in all the three cases Misc. Case no. 23 of 2019 for hearing, Misc. (Execution) case no. 18 of 2021 and Misc. (Execution) case no. 19 of 2021 for payment and that day as the Regular P.O was on leave the next date fixed in the case was 11.11.2022 in Misc. Case no. 23 of 2019 for hearing, Misc.

(Execution) case no. 18 of 2021 and Misc. (Execution) Case no. 19 of 2021 for payment I/d W.A.

6. That on 11.11.2022 the complainant went to her appointed Ld. Advocate Bhairab Das (Witness no. 2) at the Raghunathpur Court Campus, ~~he accordingly~~ ^(Purulia) took the attendance of the complainant in the attendance petitions and submitted the same before the Ld. Court at the very first hours of the Court hours.

That after sometimes both, the complainant along with her Advocate went before the Ld. Court for submitting their contention before the Ld. Court {Ld. J.M (1st Court), Raghunathpur} in reference to all the three cases wherein they both came to know that Misc. (Execution) case no. 18 of 2021 was dropped on 18.10.2022 and Misc. (Execution) case no. 19 of 2021 was dropped on 15.10.2022. Not only not that but Misc. Case no. 23 of 2019 was also dropped on 01.11.2022.

8. That both the Ld. Advocate (witness no.2) of the complainant and the complainant herself got astonished knowing the fact of disposal of the cases without their involvement or consent.

9. That on careful perusal of the case records of Misc. (Execution) case no. 18 of 2021 it could be learnt that there were some petitions like put up petition, money receipt dated 18.10.2022 stating that the complainant has received the entire arrear amount of Rs. 76000/- (Rupees Seventy Six Thousands only) in total, a Vakalathnama on behalf of the Opposite party along with an attendance. Later going through the petitions it could be learnt that the signatures of the complainant in the petition, identifying signature of the Ld. Advocate of the complainant and the identifying signature of the Ld. Advocate of the Opposite Party were all fake and done by any person with ill motive and Mens Rea of defrauding the complainant and deprive her from getting her legally appreciated money.

10. That on careful perusal of the case records of Misc. (Execution) case no. 19 of 2021 it could be learnt that there were some petitions like put up petition, money receipt dated 15.10.2022 stating that the complainant has received the entire arrear amount of Rs. 68000/- (Rupees Sixty Eight Thousands only) in total, a Vakalathnama on behalf of the Opposite party along with an attendance. Later going through the petitions it could be learnt that the signatures of the complainant in the petition, identifying signature of the Ld. Advocate of the complainant and the identifying signature of the Ld. Advocate of the Opposite Party were all fake and done by any

11. That on careful perusal of the case records of Misc. Case no. 29 of 2019, it could be learnt that there were some petitions like put up petition, case withdrawn petition dated 01.11.2022 stating that the matter has been amicably settled among the parties, etc. Later going through the petitions it could be learnt that the signatures of the complainant in the petition, identifying signature of the Ld. Advocate of the complainant and the identifying signature of the Ld. Advocate of the Opposite Party were all fake and done by any person with ill motive and Mens Rea of defrauding the complainant and deprive her from getting her legally appreciated money/remedies.

12. That the neither the complainant nor the Advocates have ever put their signatures in the petitions and the other documents dated 15.10.2022, 18.10.2022 and 01.11.2022 in the above mentioned cases. They are all caused by false personation. The accused persons have committed forgery, intending that the documents shall be used for the purpose of cheating.

13. That it is very much clear that the accused person no. 1 along with his associates with ill motive and Mens Rea have misrepresented the matters before the Ld. Court and cheated by personation by producing another person before the Ld. Court and representing her to be the complainant for which the Ld. Court passed the order of disposal of the three cases.

14. That the accused persons not only deprived the complainant of her legal rights for their illegal gain, but they deceived the entire Judicial System which would result a great threat to the society at large.

15. That it's a grave crime committed by the accused person no.1 along with his associates which should be brought under light after investigation and should be punished as per law for the Interest of Justice.

16. That the complainant went to the Raghunathpur Police Station to lodge her complaint but the Police did not pay any heed to her complaint later the complainant had send her written complaint addressing the I.C Raghunathpur P.S on 24.11.2022 through registered post bearing Postal receipt no. RW585299745IN ,which was delivered to the addresses on 25.11.2022 but since then neither any case has been lodged

against the accused persons nor any initiative has been taken by the police concerned.

That as the Police Station did not take any initiative the complainant send her written complaint addressing the Superintendent of Police on 12.12.2022 through registered post bearing Postal receipt no. RW587038972IN, which was delivered to the addresses on 13.12.2022 but till date neither any case has been lodged against the accused persons nor any initiative has been taken by the police concerned regarding investigation into the matter concerned.

18. That the entire incidence took place on 15.10.2022, 18.10.2022 and 01.11.2022 at about 10:30 a.m onwards (during Court working hours) in the Court of the Ld. J.M (1st Court), Raghunathpur, Purulia hence this Ld. Court have ample Jurisdiction to entertain this complaint.

19. That, proper Police investigation should be taken up by treating this complaint as F.I.R and action should be taken against the accused persons as per Law for the Interest of Justice.

20. That, as I.C Raghunathpur Police Station on specific information of the complaint have not instituted any F.I.R , let this complaint be forwarded to the I.C Raghunathpur Police Station for treating the same as F.I.R and for undertaking investigation.

21. That the complainant being victim of such fraudulent acts against her have no other alternative then to approach this Ld. Court for Justice.

22. That as required all the formalities of Lodging complaint U/S- 154 Cr.P.C, U/S- 154(3) Cr.P.Code has duly been complied with by the complainant.

Hence it is prayed that Your Honour will graciously be pleased to pass appropriate Orders U/S- 156(3) Cr.P.C by directing I.C Raghunathpur Police Station to treat the complaint as F.I.R and undertake proper investigation.
