The above named complainant begs to state
as follows:-

1--- That your petitioner is the legally married wife of accused Fatik Kumar . The parties are Kumbhakar by caste and Hindu by religion . Their marriage was solemnised on 15th Kartik 1419 B.S. , according to their customary rites and formalities prevalent in their community. The Marriage is duly consummated and out of their wed lock a male child (Still Birth) is born to them but he is no more . The marriage tie between them still subsists . .

2---That at the time of marriage , as per demand of the accused persons , father of the petitioner had to give considerable dowry including a hard cash of Rs.1,51, 000/- , ornaments , utensils, etc. to the accused persons but the accused persons were not satisfied with the same .

3---That after marriage the petitioner had been to her matrimonial home with a lot of hope and started to live there as husband wife in a joint mess consisting of her parents in laws for 15/20 days or so thereafter her husband in collusion with his parent started a fresh demand of Rs.50,000/- , Fridge , Colour T.V. and Palank form her father and asked to bring the same from her father . The accused persons also asked the petitioner to convey their demand to her father and she must bring the same otherwise she would have no place in their house they threatened . Accordingly your petitioner conveyed the fresh demand of the accused persons to her poor father who was very much surprised and shocked and expressed his inability to meet the fresh demand.

4---That when the money as demanded by the accused persons was not given by the poor father of the petitioner , all the accused persons became furious and vindictive towards the petitioner and started various mental and physical tortures upon the her without any fault .Off and on she was assaulted by her husband accused Fatik Kumar , at the ill advise and instigation of his parents and aunt . She was denied square meal by her mother in law Puspa Kumar and aunt . She was not allowed to enter the bed room of her husband and compelled her alone to do the entire work of the family from dawn to dusk .

5----That it may be mentioned here that being a devoted Hindu wife your petitioner had to bear those tortures , assault, cruelties and harassment patiently on the hope that her husband other in laws would mend themselves and would be normal towards her but her hopes was never materialised and became shattered .Day by day the volume of torture, assault, cruelties , fresh demand and harassments were gradually intensified and exercised upon her by the accused persons which were beyond description . She was treated as a unpaid maid servant and denied any rest to her . The accused Kalipada Kumar, Puspa Kumar and aunt used to poisoned the ear of her husband and insists him to beat the petitioner .The petitioner was help less at the hands of the accused persons .How ever she was conceived and hearing the pregnancy of the petitioner all the accused persons became furious and vindictive towards her , accused Puapa Kumar and aunt advised her to abort her pregnancy . When the petitioner refused to abort her pregnancy at this tortures , assault and harassment were intensified upon the petitioner by the accused persons which were beyond description . The accused persons threatened the petitioner until and unless Rs. 50000/-, Fridge, T.V. and Palank are not given by her father they would not keep her and maintain her . In the last part of Baisakh 1420 B.S. her husband beaten her mercilessly and kicked on her belly . There after the petitioner became ill and feeling unwell . In the belly she feeling acute pain and profuse bleeding started. The petitioner condition of the petitioner became critical then her parents were informed she was shifted to Pathardih B.P.H.C. and admitted there as an indoor patient . The doctor of Pathardih B.P.H.C. anyhow saved the life of the petitioner but her child in the womb was died in the said Hospital .Her husband or other in laws never come to see the petitioner at Pathardih Hospital nor keep any information of her . After discharge from hospital she constrained to take shelter in her father's house at Village Shrabandih .

6----That after waiting for 2/3 months or so, on 1st. Ashar 1420 B.S., again her father and one Gipa Kumar reached the petitioner to her matrimonial home but the accused persons did not allow her to enter the house and again drove her out holding the neck of the petitioner .The accused persons threatened that they are negotiating for the second marriage of accused Fatik Kumar which would ensure them further lucrative dowry . Thereafter her husband has contracted second marriage with one Jharna Kumar daughter Jagannath Kumar of village Pathardih under P.S. Baghmundi

7---That though the petitioner reported the matter to the local Police Station but the police was found evasive to take legal action against the accused persons best known to them . Thereafter , your petitioner knocked the door of the Superintendent of Police Purulia on 13-12-2022, but nothing has been done from his good office though the accused persons have committed the offences of causing persistent mental and physical tortures, cruelty and assault to the complainant tried to kill the petitioner and her child in her womb and ultimately kill her child by kicking in her belly and the accused persons in furtherance of their common intentions have committed the offences of intentionally cause hurt to the complainant .

8---That the complainant is a very poor and helpless lady having no source of income whatsoever . She is not in a position to conduct the case on her own expenses . Moreover , there are some technical and legal aspects involved in this case which also requires considerable money and machinery . For all these , it is highly desirable that this case should be converted to a police case.

Pleased to direct the Officer In Charge Baghmundi Police Station to investigate the case in accordance with law , treating the same as F.I.R. , as contemplated U/S 156(3) Cr.P.C.
