




4.Occurrence: From the very inception of Marriage i.e. on 24th. Baisakh 1413, and on wards particularly on 1st. Ashwin 1429 B.S. which is still continuing.

5.Offences:- U/S


The above named complainant begs to state as follows:-

1— That your petitioner is the legally married wife of accused Paban Paramanik . The parties are Napit by caste and Hindu by religion . Their marriage was solemnised on 24th. Baisakh 1413 B.S. , according to their customary rites and formalities prevalent in their community. The Marriage is duly consummated and out of their wed lock a male child (Sumanta Paramanik) is born to them but he is no more . The marriage tie between them still subsists . .

2---That at the time of marriage, as per demand of the accused persons, father of the petitioner had to give considerable dowry including a hard cash of Rs.80, 000/-, ornaments, utensils, etc. to the accused persons but the accused persons were not satisfied with the same.

3---That after marriage the petitioner had been to her matrimonial home with a lot of hope and started to live there as husband wife in a joint mess consisting of her mother in law and five sister in laws for 20/22 days or so thereafter her husband in collusion with his mother nd sisters started a fresh demand of Rs. 50,000/-, form her father and asked to bring the same from her brothers. The accused persons also asked the petitioner to convey their demand to her brothers and she must bring the same otherwise she would have no place in their house they threatened. Accordingly your petitioner conveyed the fresh demand of the accused persons to her poor brothers who was very much surprised and shocked and expressed his inability to meet the fresh demand.

4---That when the money as demanded by the accused persons was not given by the poor brothers of the petitioner, all the accused persons became furious and vindictive towards the petitioner and started various mental and physical tortures upon the her without any fault .Off and on she was assaulted by her husband accused Paban Paramanik , at the ill advise and instigation of his mother and sisters . She was denied square meal by her mother in law Rumabala Paramanik . She was not allowed to enter the bed room of her husband and compelled her stay in the open Varanda . She was compelled to do the entire work of the family alone from dawn to dusk .




She was treated as a unpaid maid servant and denied any rest to her. The accused Rumabal Paramanik and her sister in laws jointly used to poisoned the ear of her husband and insists him to beat the petitioner. The petitioner was help less at the hands of the accused persons. How ever she was conceived and hearing the pregnancy of the petitioner all the accused persons became furious and vindictive towards her. The petitioner gave birth to a male baby then the tortures assault and harassment were intensified upon the petitioner by the accused persons which were beyond description. The accused persons threatened the petitioner until and unless Rs. 80,000/-, is not given by her brothers they would not keep and maintain the petitioner and her baby. Off and on she was beaten by the accused persons at their whims and pleasure. In the last Ashar 1429 B.S. her husband beaten her mercilessly and reached the petitioner and her minor son to her father's house at village Pichasi and asked her poor father for Rs. 80000/-, but her father expressed his inability then her husband started to assault her in presence of the brothers and others and hurriedly fled away.

5---That thereafter on 1st, day of Ashwin 1429 B.S. oover the issue of fresh demand her husband Paban Paramanik and sisters in laws beat her mercilessly drove her out from her matrimonial home.

5---That after 4/5 days again her brothers Nepal Paramanik and one Rajib Paramanik reached the petitionerand her son to her matrimonial home but the accused persons did not allow her to enter the house and again drove her out holding the neck of the petitioner .The accused Paban Paramanik again negotiating for his second marriage which would ensure him further lucrative dowry .

6----That it may be mentioned here that being a devoted Hindu wife , your petitioner had to bears those tortures, cruelties, assault patiently seeing the face of her minor son and on the hope that her husband and other in laws would mend themselves and would be normal towards her but her hope was never materialised and became shattered . Day by day the volume of tortures, cruelties, and assault were gradually exercised upon the petitioner by all the accused persons which were unbearable and beyond description . Under compulsion the petitioner and her son took shelter in the house of her brothers at village Pichasi under P.S. Tamna .

8----That though the petitioner reported the matter to the local Police Station but the police was found evasive to take legal action against the accused persons best known to them . Thereafter , your petitioner knocked the door of the Superintendant of Police Purulia on 21-11-2022, but nothing has been done from his good office though the



accused persons have committed the offences of causing persistent mental and physical and mental tortures, cruelty and assault to the complainant and the accused persons in furtherance of their common intentions have committed the offences of intentionally cause hurt to the complainant.

9—That the complainant is a very poor and helpless lady having no source of income whatsoever. She is not in a position to conduct the case on her own expenses. Moreover, there are some technical and legal aspects involved in this case which also requires considerable money and machinery. For all these, it is highly desirable that this case should be converted to a police case.

It is prayed that your Honour may be graciously

Pleased to direct the Officer In Charge Manbazar Police Station to investigate the case in accordance with law, treating the same as F.I.R., as contemplated U/S 156(3) Cr.P.C.
