Respected Sir,

In producing herewith approx 6 (six) tons coal out of this 02 (two) Kg's coal seized as Sample with proper seizure list. The fact of the case in brief is that on 19.02.2023 at about 06:00 hrs. when myself along with force were on special mobile duty then received a source information that some persons near Parkidih village engaged for procuring and transporting of illegal coal for clandestine business hatching a criminal conspiracy with a view to wrongful gain after forming a racket.

Accordingly I informed the matter to you and as per your direction I along with force went there to work out the information.

Accordingly I along with accompanying force reached at that spot at about 06:45hrs. Seeing our police van from a distance one person who was engaged for procuring the coal managed to escape before we could get at him. After that, we searched the spot and found approx 06 (six) tons coal out of this 02 (two) Kg's coal seized as Sample from that spot. Accordingly, I held local enquiry to know the involved persons to establish identity and learned that, Wahid Ansari @ Khan s/o Md. Abdul Ansari of Vill. - Parkidih, PS- Purulia (M), Dist. - Purulia is engaged for procuring the coal. I seized the above noted articles with proper seizure list duly signed by the available witnesses. It is reasonable to belief that above noted person who managed to flee away from that spot was engaged for procuring, and transporting of illegal coal for clandestine business hatching a criminal conspiracy with a view to wrongful gain. So the above noted person is liable for committing an offence punishable U/S 379/411/414 IPC & r/w Sec 21 (1) (4) Mines and Minerals (R&D) Act 1957.

I therefore pray that, kindly start a specific case against above noted person as per law and arrange its investigation.
