I, SI Sk. Afiruddin, O/C, Arsha PS do hereby lodge this FIR as sou-moto against 1. Driver namely Md. Ahasan (56Y) S/O- Lt. Md. Khalil of Vill- Balarampur Masjid Para, PS- Balarampur, Dist- Purulia, helpers 2. Sabir Soudagar (38 yrs) S/o Yakub Soudagar of Vill- Kumirdiha, PS- Arsha, 3. Adhikari Majhi (40 yrs) S/O Hariram Majhi of Kourang, PS- Arsha, 4. Sachin Sahis (22 yrs) S/O Shankar Sahis of Kourang, PS- Arsha and owner of seized truck having Reg. no. WB37A/8787 along loaded with coal dust approx 17 ton.

Today on 09.03.2023 at 12.35 hrs during my mobile duty received information from source that one truck having Reg. no. WB37A/8787 loaded with coal dust carrying and processing illegal which was standing near Kourang village beside Purulia-Tata road (NH-32). After reaching myself along with (i) C/- 1140 Dayamay Mahato and (ii) C/-109 Surjatapa Dolai both of Arsha PS vide C.C No. 642 Dtd.09.03.2023 found the above noted truck coming towards Purulia. Myself accompanying force got down from Police van and stop the said truck. On checking found said truck loaded with coal dust approx 17 ton. On demand truck driver failed to produced any valid documents in respect of loaded coal dust and he did not gave any satisfactory account in respect of carrying coal dust. Accordingly I seized the truck having Reg. no. WB37A/8787 loaded with 17 ton coal dust and 05 Kg approx coal dust taken from vehicle for sample and arrest the above noted driver and helpers after observing norms of arrest.

On preliminary enquiry, it could be learnt that the driver & helpers of the truck bearing Reg. No. WB37A/8787 and its owner are procured the said illegal coal dust and transporting the same in a clandestine manner to another.

So, it is reasonable to believe that the driver of the truck and his owner have procure the said coal dust illegally either by theft or by any fraudulent means and trying to dispose the same coal dust in a clandestine manner to another. Accordingly I made proper arrangement and brought the seized truck loaded with coal dust at PS to keep at PS compound.

On arrival at PS I type this letter of complaint at our PS computer. Hence I do record Arsha PS Case No 30/23 dated 09.03.2023 U/S- 379/411/414/120B IPC & 30(2) CMN Act. as sou-moto against driver named Md. Ahasan (56Y) S/O- Lt. Md.
