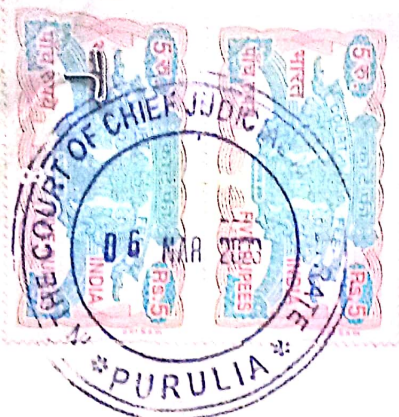

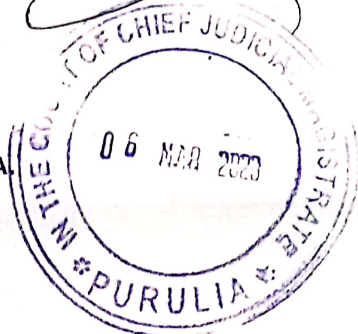

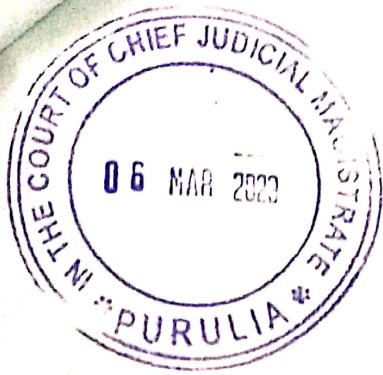

- for his employment since 2001 and occasionally used to visit his ancestral place.
2. That the petitioner in the month of February 2023 came to his village and suddenly received a notice issued by B. L and L. R. O, Balarampur regarding hearing of a mutation proceeding in respect of his property and on the date fixed i.e on 9/ 2/ 23 appeared before BL and LRO Balarampur.
  3. That the petitioner came to learn that Biswanath Mahato and Bhagatharn Mahato (accused No. 1 and 2) had applied for mutation of the property of the petitioner by stating that the petitioner had transferred his property in favor of them by executing a deed before A. D. S. R, Balarmppur . The petitioner was astonished and then and there raised his objection before the B. L and L. R. O Balarampur.
  4. That the petitioner on search and after getting the certified copy of the deed on 22/2/23 came to learn that by a deed being no. 1713 for the year 2008 of A. D. S. R, Balarampur <sup>on 9.6.08</sup> one false and fabricated deed was manufactured by the accused persons and on perusal of the certified copies of the deed the petitioner came to learn that by using his photograph the deed was manufactured. It was falsely depicted that the petitioner had transferred the Schedule property to the accused No. 1 and 2. The signatures and LTIs as used in the deed are not that of the petitioner. The petitioner has every doubt that his uncle Sudhir Mahato had supplied the picture of the petitioner to the accused persons
  5. That it is stated in the recital of the deed that the petitioner had received rupees 10000/-(ten thousand only) but that statement is false as the petitioner had never executed any such deed.

6. That some other person has impersonated the petitioner in executing and registering the deed in question and Daman Chandra Mahato and Nitai Chandra Mahato (accused No. 3 and 4) had put their signatures to the deed as witnesses.
7. That the petitioner submits that the accused persons in connivance with each other manufactured the forged deed of sale and they are using the instrument for the purpose of cheating and impersonated the petitioner. The petitioner had informed the matter to the officer in-charge Balarampur PS and had also reported the matter to the superintendent of the police Purulia on 24/2/23 but till date no action was taken.
8. That the present case involved seizure of document, comparison of signature and LTIs through expert and accordingly a through police probe is required which cannot be done by a private individual.

It is therefore prayed that your honor may be graciously pleased to send this petition of complaint to the O. C Balarampur directing him to register this petition as FIR and to cause investigation into the office

AND for which act of kindness your petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.
