2. That ^{at} the time of marriage father of the petitioner complied to pay Rs.5,00,000/- (five lakhs) to the accused no.1 and his family members alongwith other ornaments and articles as per their demand.
3. That after few days from the date of marriage started to physical and mental torture due to insufficient of dowry given by the father of your petitioner and all the family

members namely Ashis Marddanya, (Husband), Haradhan Marddanya (father-in-law), Debasis Marddanya (elder brother-in-law), Rani Marddanya (mother-in-law) and Sarita Marddanya (w/o ~~Ashis~~ Marddanya) i.e. Bara jaa, all are residing in same mess and family started to put pressure to bring Additional further dowry money from the father's house of your petitioner and as and when petitioner refused, then all type of brutal work started upon the petitioner by aforesaid accused persons every they assault her off and ~~and~~ frequently.

4. That being helpless house wife petitioner tried her best to adjust with the accused and in the mean time one daughter nameiy Sreya Marddanya has been born, now aged about 5 years residing with the mother and after birth of aforesaid daughter the physical and mental torture increased day to day and finally it was ~~unable~~ ^{unbearable} and then petitioner informed the matter to her father and other villagers of village Penchara and the accused persons snached all the documents of the petitioner and her daughter and drove her out from the house.

5. That on several time accused also take attempt to killed her but petitioner did not take any legal steps for future adjustment.

6. That heaving such type of inhuman behavior of the

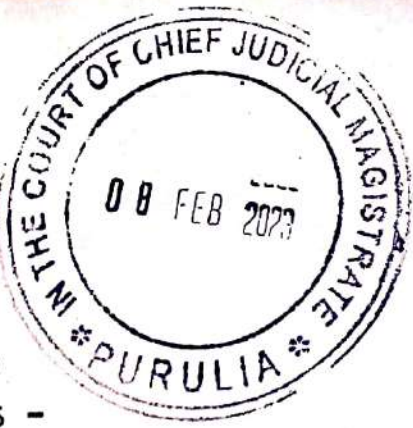

8. That the accused also threatened to your petitioner by saying that they all ready filed a divorce case before the court.

9. That having no other alternative petitioner ~~along~~ ^{with} other ^{companion} ~~leaving~~ then and there went to the Balarampur P. S. and informed the matter but as the accused persons are very influencial persons as such the ~~motion~~ ^{matter} of law was not star-

10. That one several time as and when petitioner asking about the position of the complaint the P.S. stated already action was started but after ^{search} ~~such~~ petitioner came to know P.S. did nothing as such the petitioner informed the matter to S.P. Purulia but all in vain.

11. That being deserted lady petitioner have no other alternative but to take the shelter of sec. 156(3) Cr.P.C. to punished the criminal as per provision of law.
