





- 1.---- That the complainant is a permanent resident of village Babujore under P. S. Barabazar, Dist. Purulia.
- 2.---- That on 24-02-2023 at about 1.30 P.M. when the complainant was passing near the house of the accused No.3 he marked the accused No.1 and 2 came to the house of the accused No.3.
3. And all of them were seating outside the house of the Accused No.3 and seeing the complainant all of them started to taunt the complainant.
- 3.---- That on 24-02-2023 at about 11.00 P.M. when the complainant was sleeping in his room at that time the above named accused persons entered into the house of complainant armed with deadly weapons and committed theft a sum of Rupees Twenty Thousand, Two bags, one pair of Golden ear ring and a pair of silver tore after broke the Box. Hearing the sound, the complainant woke and saw that the miscreants fled away from the back side of house of the complainant. The complainant sustained a loss of Rupees Fifty thousand and the coiplaint makes a noise by saying "Bancho - Bancho" hearing the news villagers came and saw the incident.
