Sub: Prayer for lodged FIR.

Sir,

In producing herewith 01 (One) seized Tractor having Eng. No CZQSE464604SM attached with sand loaded Trolley, about 100 Cft. (Approx) with proper seizure list.

I beg to state that today (23.03.2023) myself along with C/347 Manas Pathak & C/897 Umapada Dhalla all of Barabazar PS performing evening mobile duty vide Barabazar PS C.C No- 815/2023 Dtd. 23.03.2023 and GDE No-2222 Dtd. 23.03.2023 with Govt vehicle. During my mobile duty as per source information that one Tractor loaded with sand coming from Tumrasole village side and as per direction of I/C Barabazar PS at about 21:05 hrs I reached at Bera more under Barabazar PS and found that one Tractor coming from Tumrasole village side, seeing the Police party the driver of said Tractor trying to fled away. On chassing the driver of said vehicle kept the Tractor on Bera-Gosaidih Morum Road near Bera Morh and fled away. I tried to find the driver of said vehicle but nobody turned up then at about 21:25 hrs I Seized the tractor attached with trolley loaded with sand, about 100 C.ft approx. from Bera-Gosaidih Morum Road near Bera Morh under Barabazar PS.

Held an enquiry about the matter and so far information collected it is crystal clear that the driver and the owner of the vehicle collected the sand by illegal means with intent to make unlawful profit by unlawful collection of sand through illegal manner by unauthorized extraction and removal of mines & minerals. By this way they violated the regulation of procurement of minor minerals. As such there is every reason to believe that the driver and owner of the said tractor with ill motive were transporting the sand illegally without any valid document in support of carrying sand. They violated the Govt. order of not extracting sand from the river. As such they were doing illegal business activities.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I pray before you that kindly take needful action against the drivers and owners of said tractors.
