Sir,

In producing here with 01(One) tractor bearing Registration No- WB55A-7367 attached with trolley loaded with sand about 100 C.ft (Approx) with proper seizure list.

I beg to state that on 28.03.2023 myself along with C/1211 Chunaram Hembram & C/3218 Sukchand Mandi all of Barabazar PS performing evening mobile duty vide C.C No- 882/2023 Dtd. 28.03.2023 and GDE No-2527 Dtd. 28.03.2023 with Govt vehicle. During my mobile duty received source information regarding loading and sending illegal sand from the side of Banjora G.P. area nearby Simudiri village. Conveyed the same to I/C Barabazar PS and as per direction I along with force reached at Simuduri morh at about 20:15 hrs as per source information.

Myself along with force started NAKA checking at Simuduri Morh from 20:15 hrs. At about 20:45 hrs and found 01 (one) tractor attached with trolley coming towards Simuduri Morh. Seen the police party the driver fled away after keeping the tractor beside the road near Simuduri Morh under Barabazar PS. Chased him but somehow he managed to escape under the cover of darkness. We found that the Tractor was loaded with sand about 100 Cft. sand .

I waiting for some time but none turned up before the police party. There is every reason to believe that the owner and driver fraudulently obtained the sand by illegal means to make profit by illegal manners with a clandestine business. Hence I seized the tractor attached with trolley loaded with sand about 100 Cft. sand under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses.

Held an enquiry about the matter and so far information collected it is crystal clear that the driver and the owner of the vehicle collected the sand by illegal means with intent to make unlawful profit by unlawful collection of sand through illegal manner by unauthorized extraction and removal of mines & minerals. By this way they violated the regulation of procurement of minor minerals. As such there is every reason to believe that the driver and owner of the said tractor with ill motive were transporting the sand illegally without any valid document in support of carrying sand. They violated the Govt. order of not extracting sand from the river. As such they were doing illegal business activities.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I pray before you that kindly take needful action against the driver and owner of said tractor.
