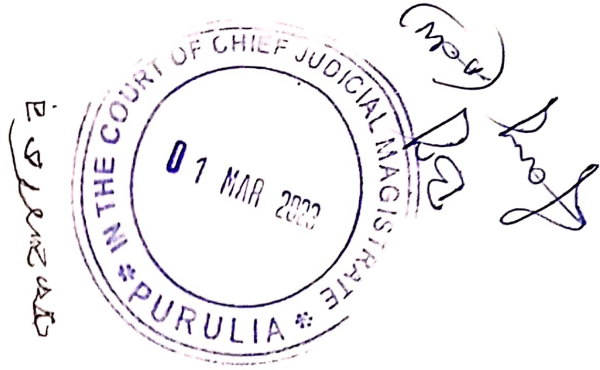

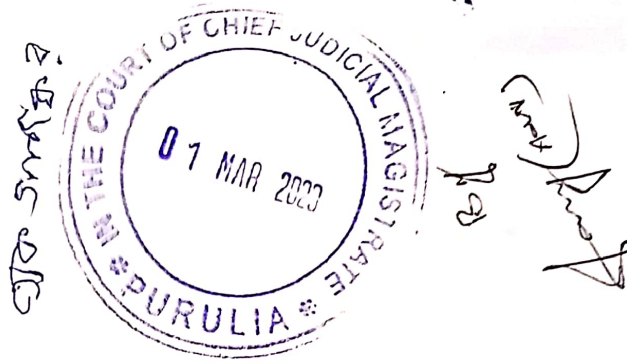

Most respectfully begs to state:

1. That the Complainant, Accused Person and the Witnesses No.2 to are the permanent resident of village Jambaid, P.S.-Hura, District-Purulia, having their residential houses therein.
2. That the Accused Person has got grudge against the family of the Complainant.
3. That when such state of things were going on, the Complainant while at his house on 04/12/2022 at 03 PM, the Accused Person without any reason came in front of the Complainant with a lathi at his hand. Suddenly the Accused Person



4. That the Complainant somehow move his head and the Accused assaulted the Complainant at his eyebrow with lathi. Due to several assault the Complainant sustained bleeding injury at his eyebrow & bodily pain on his other parts of the body.
5. That the Complainant out of fear of life tried to flee away there from but the Accused Person blocked him to assault further but could not succeed.
6. That the Complainant raised hue & cry and on hearing such noise several local villagers including the Witnesses reached there and on seeing them the Accused Persons fled away.
7. That after the incident the Complainant with the help of villagers reached Hura BPHC for treatment & after treatment Hura BPHC discharged the Complainant with advice of proper medication.
8. That the Complainant thereafter on several occasions met the O/C Hura P.S. informing all about the incident & requesting him to take steps against the Accused Person but the police did not take any action in the matter up-till now.
9. That the Complainant also informed the matter to the S.P. Purulia on 17/02/2023 but up-till now no action has been taken by the police.
10. That the Complainant due to such incident and the threatening of the Accused Person, the Complainant living with anxiety and he has fear of life.
11. That thus the Complainant brought this case for the offences committed by the Accused Persons for which they are liable to be prosecuted.

It is therefore prayed that your honour may graciously be pleased to treat this petition as a Complaint under Section-156(3) of the Cr.P.C. & send the petition to the O/C Hura P.S. for investigation & further be pleased to pass necessary order.
