Respected sir,

In producing herewith one seized tractor (Mahindra B/275 DI) having Registration number WB 81/1427 along with trolley loaded with sand, attached with Seizure List. The nub of the fact in a nutshell is that today (04.03.2023) while I, along with C/1183 Subhas Kundu and NVF/ 593 Thakurdas Soren, were performing mobile duty vide Santaldih I.C. (BCW) G.D.E. No. 78, dt. 04.03.2023, in Santaldih I.C. area, I, received a tip off at 17:05 hrs on 04.03.2023 that, at Nabagram village more under Santaldih PS, some persons were illegally carrying sand by a suspicious tractor. Subsequently, I along with force proceeded toward Nabagram village more to work out the tip off. While, I along with force arrived at Nabagram village more under Santaldih PS and found that, some persons are illegally carrying sand into a tractor attached with trolley.

I, along with force proceeded to detain the vehicle and reached at the spot i.e. Nabagram village more, PS - Santaldih at 17:35 hrs but seeing the police persons the driver left the tractor and ran away with the advantage of jungle. We waited but none turn up to produce any valid documents in respect of the said tractor as well as loaded sand in it. It is clear that the owner of the tractor is running this clandestine business by means of illegal transportation of sand for their wrongful gain.

During enquiry, it is ascertain that the said tractor loaded the sand in by illegal means for selling the same to make profit by dishonestly and they had been running a clandestine business by transporting the same at Jharkhand State. So, it is reason to believe that they in cahoots with the owner of the vehicle procured the said sand from Damodar river bank by fraudulently means or theft by any means for transporting the same at Jharkhand State to run clandestine business. As per source information, they are habitual offender of this crime, as they have been engaged in the said illegal sand leafing business since long, behind the eyes of the administration.

So, I seized the above noted tractor along with trolley loaded with sand with proper seizure list duly signed by witnesses. Thereafter, I brought the seized tractor along with the loaded sand into the trolley to Santaldih PS.

Under above fact and circumstances, I, pray before you to start a specific case against owner and driver of the above noted tractor having Registration number WB 81/1427, under proper sections of law.
