Sir,

In producing herewith one seized Red Colour Mahindra Tractor, Model 475 DI SP Plus having Eng No- RND2JAA0954 & Chasis No- MBNTFAJBENRD00579 along with sand loaded trolley under proper seizure list, I beg to submit that today on (19.04.2023) I along with (1) C/2932 Alok Majhi (2) C/2228 Pradip Lohar, 3) NVF/908 Lakhindar Sing Mura all of Suisa OP Camp under Baghmundi P.S were performing mobile duty vide Suisa OP CC No- 803/2023, Date-19.04.2023. During my mobile duty at about 20:15 hrs I received a source information that a suspicious tractor loaded with sand was coming from Battar Village (Jhalda PS) side. I informed this matter to I/C Suisa OP as well as O/C Baghmundi PS and after getting necessary permission I along with force left for the said place.

While I along with force arrived at Peretorang village at 20:55 hrs, found that one tractor was coming from Battar Village (Jhalda PS) side and seeing the Police party the driver of the said tractor fled away leaving the said tractor. Following the driver of the Tractor, myself along with three force namely (1) C/2932 Alok Majhi (2) C/2228 Pradip Lohar, (leaving the other force NVF/908 Lakhindar Sing Mura near tractor as guard) started chasing the driver. Due to dense forest and topography of the area, the driver of the said vehicle somehow managed to escape in a suspicious manner. Due to such suspicious activity of the driver it was ascertained that he with the consent of the owner of the vehicle had been running a clandestine business by illegal means for selling the same to make profit by dishonestly. Hence it is reasoned to belief that the driver of the vehicle procured the said sand from Subarnarekha river bed by fraudulently means or theft by any means for transporting the same to run clandestine business along with the owner of the vehicle. Hence, I seized the tractor vide Eng No- RND2JAA0954 & Chasis No- MBNTFAJBENRD00579 along with trolley loaded with sand and 01 KG (Approx) sand from said trolley as sample in between 21:15 hrs to 21:25 hrs under proper seizure list duly signed by witnesses. I brought the said sand loaded tractor to Baghmundi P.S compound as such there is every reason to believe that the driver and owner of the vehicle with ill motive dealing with sand illegally without any valid document.

Therefore, I pray before you that a case may kindly be started and arrange for its investigation.
