Sub: Written Complaint against Md. Jainul Haque and his accomplices who were driving Hyundai Santro Car, of Red/Maroon colour bearing registration no. JH 10V 7811.

Sir,

I, Sangita Rajak, Age- 44 years, resident at Surya Taran-2, A-5/58 Diamond Park (Joka), Kolkata-700104, widow of Late Biswajit Rajak, under extremely painful, traumatized, and agonizing state of mind want to lodge this complaint against Md. Jainul Haque, S/O-Abdul Majid Ansary of Vill-Baranawtand, PS-Govindpur, Dist-Dhanbad, Jharkhand and his accomplices for knowingly causing the death of my husband, Late Biswajit Rajak, Age 49 years, S/o: Late Maheswar Rajak.

On 12-04-2023 at about 8:15 p.m., my husband had parked his motorcycle, bearing registration number WB56F6079 on the side of Ranchi road at Maguria village area for using his phone. Biswajit Rajak was travelling to Badri Ashram with an acquaintance namely Shukla Chakraborty as a pillion rider. While he was using the phone, a four-wheeler, Hyundai Santro, Model Hatchback make, of red/maroon colour, bearing registration number JH 10V 7811 dashed my husband and his acquaintance at an extremely high speed resulting in my husband's death on the spot. Shukla Chakraborty was fatally injured.

The car was driven by Md. Jainul Haque with his accomplices in an uncontrollable high-speed having full knowledge that any impact with such high speed shall cause the death of my husband.

The passersby on the road immediately apprehended the driver but were unable to apprehend the accomplices. Some of the passersby made attempts to carry my husband and Shukla Chakraborty to the hospital. At the hospital it was informed that Biswajit Rajak was brought in dead. Shukla Chakraborty died within half an hour of reaching the hospital.

It was reported by the eye witnesses that the driver and his accomplices may have been intoxicated at that point in time. It has also been reported that before dashing my husband and killing him, Md. Jainul Haque and his accomplices while using the same car bearing registration number JH 10V 7811 dashed another motorcycle carrying riders. It has been reported that the

earlier dashed motorcycle riders are in the hospital in serious condition and have suffered fatal injuries.


It is thus clear that Md. Jainul Haque and his accomplices have knowingly caused the death of my husband and his acquaintance namely Shukla Chakraborty and have caused mischief and damage of public life and property which are extremely serious offences.

My husband was residing in Purulia for his Service purposes. I am a housewife residing with my two unmarried dependent daughters who are students at Kolkata. I am feeling extremely destitute and fearful of my family's safety and security. Feeling extremely helpless, I request and beg you to take appropriate action against the perpetrators of such heinous crimes who have intentionally and knowingly taken the life of my innocent husband and his acquaintance for no fault on their part.

It has also been reported that my husband was dashed and run over from behind by the Santro car bearing registration number JH 10V 7811 and dragged for quite a distance and for such reason my husband could not save himself.


I had a slight delay in lodging the complaint because of getting engaged in performing the last rite rituals of my husband and I was in extreme emotional distress and shock as well.
