Respected Sir,

In producing herewith 02 (two) arrested accused persons namely 1. Sk. Tajiul (40 Yrs) S/O-Sk. Jardis 2. Sk. Manik (33 Yrs) S/o-Sk. Rabbul both of village Murulia, PS-Santuri, Dist-Purulia along with 02 (Two) Buffalo carts with approx 02 (Two) tons coal each cart with 04 (Four) black buffaloes out of these 01 (one) kg coal from each cart seized as Sample with proper seizure list.

The fact of the case in brief is that today (19.05.2023) at about 17.15 hrs when myself along with force were on mobile duty then received a source information that some persons near at Madrasha School of Murulia village engaged in transporting coal after procuring the same in illegal manner in 02 (Two) Buffalo carts with a view to wrongful gain.

Accordingly, I conveyed this source information to O/C Santuri PS and as per his direction I along with force proceeded for the anticipated place to work out the information.

Subsequently, I along with accompanying force reached at that spot near Madrasha School at about 17:45 hrs as per the information and as described by the source. We found two persons who were engaged in transporting coal with two buffalo carts proceed towards Murulia Village. Seeing the police party they tried to flee away from the buffalo cart but after a hot chase we managed to apprehend them. After that we searched the place and its adjacent areas and found 02 (Two) Buffalo carts loaded with approx 02 (Two) tons coal in each cart. On being asked, they failed to produce any valid paper against said loaded coal. Accordingly, I., seized the 02 (Two) buffalo carts loaded with approx 02 (Two) tons coal in each cart under proper seizer list out of which one kg coal from each cart seized as sample. On interrogation the apprehended persons, they confessed that they engaged for extracting, lifting and transporting of illegal coal with a view to wrongful gain after procuring the same by theft or any fraudulent means. After that I arrested them and maintaining all formalities regarding arrest. So the above noted persons are liable for committing an offence punishable U/S 379/411/414 IPC & r/w Sec 30(2) CMN Act, 1973.

I therefore pray that kindly start a specific case against above noted persons as per law and arrange its investigation.
